The Department of Education (DepEd) Central Office, in partnership with the members of the National Teachers' Month Coordinating Council (NTMCC), annually conducts activities to celebrate the National Teachers' Month pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 242, s.2011 and culminates it through the National Teachers' Day (NTD) / World Teachers' Day (WTD) Celebration on October 5, 2019, pursuant to Republic Act No. 10743.

This year, the National Teachers' Day celebration shall be held at the Atrium, Limketkai Mall, Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City with the theme: Gurong Pilipino: Kasama sa Mapagpalayang Educkasyon. This event shall be primarily participated by DepEd Regions IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA and BARMM together with teacher-participants from all other regions, and representatives from the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA).

The Department is counting on your active support and assistance in mounting this event for our teachers. Similar to past celebrations, please be advised of the following requirements and concerns:

I. Allocation of Teachers per Region

Each participant should bring their own printed event ticket which will be presented at the gate of the event venue. Each event ticket has a unique code which will be scanned upon entrance. This will ensure security, safety, and participation in the activities especially in the raffle draws. Attached is the sample event ticket (Enclosure 2).

All participants are advised to bring their DepEd or School IDs which must be presented together with the e-tickets at the entrance gates and upon claiming of raffle prize (if applicable). Kindly note that **only participants with e-tickets shall be allowed entry**. E-tickets are non-transferable.

VI. Raffle Draws

Raffle draws shall be done during the morning and afternoon programs to ensure fairness and to spread the chances of winning for everyone who will participate in the event. Regions IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA and BARMM, shall each have a separate tambiolo, while another tambiolo shall be provided for the other regions.

The number of winners which will be drawn from each tambiolo will be based on the percentage of participants per region.

Raffle winners should present their e-ticket and proof of identification to claim their prizes at the designated area.

VII. Teachers' Fair

A Teachers' Fair shall be set up at the event venue. The fair shall feature exhibits, food booths, giveaways, and tokens from our partner stakeholders.

VIII. Schedule of Activities

The gates of the event venue shall open as early as 5:30 a.m. Booths at the Teachers' Fair shall also open around the same time so that the booths will be made available to be visited by the participants once they have arrived at the venue.

There will be a morning and an afternoon program.

IX. Certificates of Appearance and Participation

Each teacher-participant shall be given Certificates of Appearance and Participation. The certificates must be claimed by the RFPs from the registration area after the event. The RFPs shall facilitate the distribution of the certificates to the teacher-participants from their respective regions.

X. Parking Areas

Due to the limited space of the event venue, vehicles must be parked at the designated parking areas outside the event venue. Thus, the participants may only be dropped off at the designated areas near the venue. There will be street signage, traffic enforcers, and/or police officers that will serve as guide to where the parking areas are located.

XI. Regional Focal Persons (RFPs)

Each Region should assign their respective focal persons whom the organizing team may coordinate with regarding the participants' information, booth set up, and other necessary details. TEACHERS' GOT TALENT Contest Guidelines

As part of this year's National Teachers' Day / World Teachers' Day Celebration at the Atrium, Limketkai Mall, Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City on October 05, 2019, the Department of Education, will again hold the Teachers' Got Talent (TGT) Competition.

- 1. The contest is open to public school teachers from Regions IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA and BARMM.
- 2. The contest is open to any type of act or performance: singing, dancing, acting, etc.
- 3. Only one contestant (or group) per school shall be allowed to join. If joining as a group, a maximum of ten (10) members shall be allowed.
- 4. The presentation should last for a maximum of seven (7) minutes only including entrance and exit. Two (2) points will automatically be deducted for exceeding prescribed duration.
- 5. Each interested individual or groups shall submit a video recording of the presentation (using phone or digital camera or other means) in a USB with the attached registration form to the External Partnerships Service-Special Events Unit (EPS-SEU). The USB shall be sent via courier to:

All entries should be submitted not later than September 14, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. All entries which will be sent beyond this time will no longer be considered.

6. The Semi-finals/elimination of the entries will be held at DepEd – SEU on September 16, 2019 from 8:00 a.m. – onwards. The 10 finalists as determined by the TGT committee will go to the finals and will receive a call and email from the committee on the following week for further instructions and guidelines.

The TGT final contest time shall be announced 3 days before the event. Failure to arrive on the said time at the designated venue shall be a ground for disqualification. General orientation and rehearsals/ blocking will be on October 4, 2019, 4:00 PM at the event venue.

- 1. The scores will be tallied at the end of all ten (10) performances.
- 2. Announcement of winners will follow shortly.
- 3. The judges' decisions are final and cannot be subjected to review, debate, contest or dispute.
- 4. The criteria for judging are as follows:


- 1. Only the 10 shortlisted entries who will perform at the finals shall be notified on September 24, 2019.
