Pursuant to Executive Order [EO] No. 203, s. 1987 titled "Providing a List of Regular Holidays and Special Days to be Observed throughout the Philippines and For Other Purposes" which declared the 9th day of April as Araw ng Kagitingan (Bataan and Corregidor Day) and Presidential Proclamation No. 466, s. 1989 titled "Declaring the Period April 5 to 11 as Philippine Veterans Week," the celebration of the Philippine Veterans Week and the 80th Anniversary of Araw ng Kagitingan will be on April 5-8, 2022 and on April 9, 2022 respectively.


Poster-Making and Oratorical Contests shall be held as part of said celebrations. The contest mechanics are provided in the attached Enclosures 1 and 2 respectively.

CONTEST MECHANICS POSTER-MAKING CONTEST

1. Background and Objectives

In celebration of the 80th Araw ng Kagitingan and Philippine Veterans Week, the Department of Education (DepEd), Philippine Veterans Affairs Office (PVAO) and the Department of National Defense (DND) are sponsoring a Poster-Making Contest.

The objectives of the contest are to increase awareness of historical places in the Philippines during World War II where veterans fought for the country and sacrificed lives and to remember the reasons why we experience freedom up to this day.

2. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 7, 8, and 9 students enrolled in any public and private secondary schools nationwide. The school should be duly recognized by DepEd. Previous winners of all the Special Events Unit organized contests are not qualified to join to give chance to others.

3. Scope/Theme

The entries should depict the life, works and heroism of our Filipino heroes who fought for our country and should be in line with this year's theme: "KAGITINGAN NO MGA BETERANO, INSPIRASYON NO NAOKAKAISANO PILIPINO."

4. Entry Specification

Only entries submitted in correct and complete specifications and format will be considered official. Please take note of the following requirements to ensure that the entry satisfies the specifications of the contest:

- 4.1 The poster should be in a 15"x 20" illustration board.
- 4.2 Contestants may use any medium of their choice.
- 4.3 The poster must be described in one or two sentences. The description must be typewritten and printed on a % A4 bond paper and posted at the back of the entry together with the following information:
 - 4.3.1 Name of Learner
 - 4.3.2 Contact Number
 - 4.3.3 School
 - 4.3.4 Division
 - 4.3.5 Region
- 4.4 The Philippine Flag should not be used as background of the poster. If used as part, it should be placed in a conspicuous place

to show its importance to the artwork (please refer to Sec. 39 – Prohibited Acts under Republic Act (RA) No. 8491 titled "An Act Prescribing the Code of the National Flag, Anthem, Motto, Coat-of-Arms and Other Heraldic Items and Devices of the Philippines.").

5. Criteria

6. Determination and Announcement of Winners

The contestant who will get the highest score shall be considered as the National Champion, the contestant with the second highest score shall be declared as the first runner-up, and the third highest shall be declared as the second runner-up, so on and so forth.

The names of the winners and process of claiming their prizes will be announced during the symposium.

7. Submission of Entries

- 7.1 The deadline for the submission of entries will be on March 25, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. Submission beyond the stated time shall be disqualified.
- 7.2 Only five (5) entries PER DIVISION are allowed. Each entry must be accompanied by the following requirements:
 - 7.2.1 Endorsement from the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) or the Chief of the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD).
 - 7.2.2 A certification from the school principal that the contestant is

CONTEST MECHANICS ORATORICAL CONTEST

Subject to such changes as may be determined appropriate, the following general rules shall apply:

1. Participants

The contest is open to all Grades 4, 5, and 6 students enrolled in any public and private elementary schools nationwide. The school should be duly recognized by DepEd. Previous winners of all Special Events Unit organized contests are not qualified to join to give chance to others.

2. Theme and Content

The oratorical piece must be in Filipino, original, never been published, and expounding on the theme: "KAGITINGAN NG MGA BETERANO, INSPIRASYON NG NAGRAKAISANG PILIPINO."

The piece must be delivered for a minimum of five (5) minutes and a maximum of seven (7) minutes.

The oration MUST NOT, in whole or in part, whether express or implied, offend any race, religious freedom, nor should it be against the laws of environment, honor and dignity, or the moral standards of Filipinos.

3. Criteria

 a. Content 	Sincerity, originality and relevance to the theme	50%
b. Delivery	Posture, gesture, eye contact, facial expression,	40%
	pronunciation, volume and mastery	
c. Persuasion	and Stage Presence	10%
