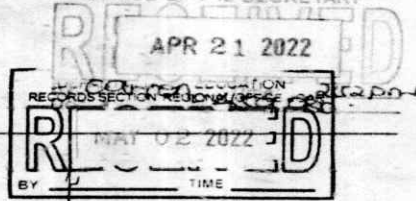

This has reference to the recently conducted Teacher-Adviser Training Course (TATC) and Student Leader Development Program (SLDP) last 15 February 2022 to 15 April 2022 via DepEd Learning Management System (DLMS).

Upon review of the said training program, it is revealed in the results that the level of completion of the enrolled teacher-advisers and student leaders were only 33% and 26% respectively.

In this regard, the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Youth Affairs and Special Concerns (OASYASC) through the Youth Formation Division (YFD) would like to inform all the teacher-advisers and student leaders that TATC and SLDP access is extended until 30 June 2022 to provide them ample time to complete the program.
