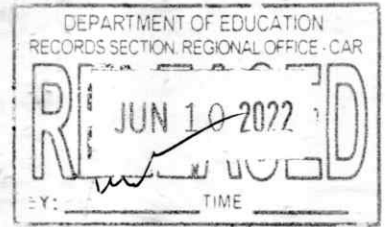

DENGUE FREE SCHOOLS: REITERATION OF DENGUE OUTBREAK PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE

TO: Schools Division Superintendents
 Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools
 All Others Concerned

1. This is to inform the field that June is Dengue Awareness Month. The Department of Health (DOH) – Cordillera Administrative Region issued an alert on the 387% increase of dengue cases in the region from January 1 to May 14, 2022, with four reported deaths, including a school-aged child.

2. In response to this crisis, all schools and DepEd offices are enjoined to conduct the following activities:

- a. Suspension of wearing skirt uniforms of students and encourage the use of loose pants and long sleeves to minimize exposed skin;
- b. Reactivation of school Dengue brigades to lead the conduct of daily or habitual search and destroy activities to eliminate breeding grounds/ containers in the school premises;
- c. Referral of dengue suspect students/ personnel to the nearest health center for early consultation; and
- d. Promote to the students the 4S strategy to be performed in the
