

REGIONAL MEMORANDUM No. 2 3 2022

DENGUE FREE SCHOOLS: REITERATION OF DENGUE OUTBREAK PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE

TO: Schools Division Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools
All Others Concerned

- 1. This is to inform the field that June is Dengue Awareness Month. The Department of Health (DOH) Cordillera Administrative Region issued an alert on the 387% increase of dengue cases in the region from January 1 to May 14, 2022, with four reported deaths, including a school-aged child.
- 2. In response to this crisis, all schools and DepEd offices are enjoined to conduct the following activities:
 - Suspension of wearing skirt uniforms of students and encourage the use of loose pants and long sleeves to minimize exposed skin;
 - Reactivation of school Dengue brigades to lead the conduct of daily or habitual search and destroy activities to eliminate breeding grounds/ containers in the school premises;
 - c. Referral of dengue suspect students/ personnel to the nearest health center for early consultation; and
 - d. Promote to the students the 4S strategy to be performed in the
