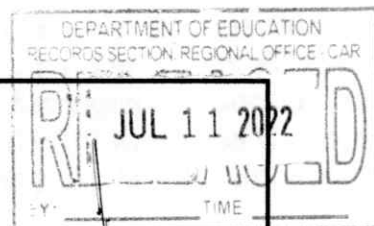
SUBJECT : **CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR) AWARENESS CAMPAIGN 2022**

DATE : **04 July 2022**

The Department of Education, through the Bureau of Learning Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), in coordination with the Youth Formation Division, and supported by the Disaster Risk Reduction Management Service, shall conduct the Nationwide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Awareness Campaign 2022 on 01-31 July 2022. The theme for this year is *Moving On, Moving Up: Pushing Harder for a CPR-Ready Philippines*.

The Nationwide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Awareness Campaign is conducted every July to celebrate the passage of Republic Act 10871 or the Basic Life Support Training in Schools Act, and to disseminate information and awareness on the importance of CPR.
