Pursuant to Republic Act No. 11468, the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Youth Affairs and Special Concerns - Youth Formation Division (OASYASC-YFD) will conduct a virtual celebration of the National Day of Remembrance for Road Crash Victims, Survivors, and Their Families on 20 November 2022 at 9:00 a.m. to 11 a.m. via Deped Tayo - Youth Formation official Facebook Page.

This activity aims to:

- 1. remember all people who passed away and seriously injured on the roads
- 2. acknowledge the crucial work of the emergency services
- 3. draw attention to the generally trivial legal response to culpable road deaths and injuries and advocate for an appropriately serious response
- 4. advocate for better support for road traffic victims and victim families.
- 5. promote evidence-based actions to prevent and eventually stop further road traffic deaths and injuries


