Greetings from the **Gerry Roxas Foundation (GRF)**! We wish to request for your endorsement and assistance in facilitating the attendance of High School Principals in all Regions to a **one-day GRF Principals Forum**.

We have learned that the local Dep-Ed divisions conduct monthly management committee meetings (Mancoms) requiring the attendance of all their high school principals. 
