



SUBJECT : **AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT THE GRADE 5 MASS TRAINING OF TEACHERS (MTOT) FOR THE K TO 12 BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAM (BEP) AND DRAW FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE**

In line with the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013 and the implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Program (BEP), the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) will conduct a nationwide training of Grade 5 teachers.

In line with this, authority is hereby requested to conduct the Grade 5 Mass Training of Teachers (MTOT) in the Regions in April 2016. Likewise, authority is requested to allocate and download funds to the Regions in the amount of **Five Hundred Forty Six Million, Four Hundred Ninety Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P 546,497,800.00)** for **88,716** Grade 5 teachers and **2,092** trainers with the following breakdown:

The funds to be downloaded to the Regions will cover the whole amount allotted to each teacher is chargeable against 2016 HRTD Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. See attached budgetary requirements per Region.

In addition, the training cost for Autonomous Region for Muslim Mindanao (ARMM) will be paid directly by the DepEd Central Office subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

The regional mass training of Grade 5 teachers will be conducted by the schools division offices (SDOs). The training shall entitle the participants and teacher-trainers a
