

MECHANICS OF THE CONTEST:

SLOGAN MAKING CONTEST: Intermediate, JRHS and SHS Levels. Things to Bring: 1/4 Illustration Board and Black Pentel Pen, Ruler and Pencil. Criteria for Judging: Relevance to the theme: 40% Clarity of Message: 20%; Creativity: 15%; Originality 15% Impact and Presentation: 10%. Total: 100%

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE QUIZ: Team Contest composed of 3 students. There will be 3 categories: Intermediate JRHS and SHS Levels. The organization will provide the materials. Questions will be based from the DepED Competencies related to the environment. Other questions will be coming from the media. 5 questions for each of the easy, average and difficult items. Easy questions 1 pt; Average questions: 2 pts and Difficult questions: 3 pts. Do or Die will be given to Clincher questions.

JINGLE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT: Group Contest composed of 5 to 10 members. There will be 3 categories: Intermediate JRHS and SHS Levels. 3 to 5 minutes presentation. Theme should revolve on how to help save the environment. Background music accompaniment is allowed. Criteria for Judging: Melodic Arrangement: 30%; Lyrical Content: 30% Harmonics/Interpretation: 30%; Mastery:10% Total: 100%

MR AND MS ASMEPPS YES.O: Grade School and HS Category. Modeling, Question and Answer, Creative Wear (materials will be given by the association-should be assisted by 2 to 3 co-participants) and Talent Contest (3 to 5 min presentation and should revolve around the theme: Help Save the Environment). 25% rating for each of the 4 categories.

All participants will receive Certificate of Participation. Top Three Winners of Contests will receive Certificate of Merit and Glass Medals. Mr. and Ms ASMEPPS YES.O will receive Sash and Certificate of Merit.
