I. ONLINE CONTESTS

A. PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Open for AMATEUR Photographers ONLY.
- 2. A resident of the Cordillera Administrative Region.

MECHANICS

- 1. The applicant will pay a registration of Php. 100.00 per entry.
- 2. The applicant may pay by cash at the nearest CBSTC Office in their place or online through Gcash and PayMaya.
- 3. Registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferrable.
- 4. The entrant may submit multiple entries. In the event that winning entries is owned by 1 entrant, the entry with the highest score shall be considered.
- 5. Submission of entries will be from April 4, 2022 to June 1, 2022.
- 6. Photo must be in JPEG format.
- 7. Applicants must be the sole and exclusive author and owner of the photograph and have the full and exclusive right, power, and authority to submit the photograph to the CBSTC 4^{th} anniversary photography contest.
- 8. The entrant should submit a photograph in relevance to the theme:

"Conveying a Pocket of Hope Transportation: Its essence becoming personal, its meaning being redefined, and its foundation magnified."

- 9. In order to keep judging process blind, submitted photos cannot be watermarked or be otherwise marked.
- 10. All photos should follow ethical photography practices.
- 11. Single Exposure photos **ONLY** with minor edits. Photo manipulation using various methods or techniques that changes the narrative of the photos submitted to fit the given theme is **NOT** allowed.
- 12. Photographs should be taken from January 2022 to June 2022.
- 13. Photographs should **NOT** include Public Utility Vehicles or any related businesses operated and owned by other Transport Cooperatives. Photographs that contain such information or footage other than those operated by the Cordillera Basic Sectors Transport Cooperative shall be immediately disqualified. When disqualified, the registration fee shall not be refunded.
- 14. Photos from Mobile cameras are accepted but it must be submitted with the highest resolution possible.
- 15. Photos from Film cameras are NOT allowed.
- 16. Photos submitted **MUST** be accompanied caption.

- 17. All winners will be given a **FREE** photography seminar and workshop with certificate.
- 18. ALL WINNING ENTRIES SHALL BECOME PROPERTIES OF THE CORDILLERA BASIC SECTORS TRANSPORT COOPERATIVE BUT WILL STILL BE CREDITED TO THE AUTHOR.

B. VIDEOGRAPHY CONTEST

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Open to AMATEUR Videographers ONLY.
- 2. A resident of the Cordillera Administrative Region.

MECHANICS

- 1. The applicant will pay a registration of Php. 100.00 per entry.
- 2. The applicant may pay by cash at the nearest CBSTC Office in their place or online through Gcash and PayMaya.
- 3. Registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferrable.
- 4. The entrant may submit multiple entries. In the event that winning entries is owned by 1 entrant, the entry with the highest score shall be considered.
- 5. Submission of entries will be from April 4, 2022 to June 1, 2022.
- 6. Entrants must be the sole and exclusive author and owner of the video and have the full and exclusive right, power, and authority to submit the video to the CBSTC 4th anniversary videography contest.
- 7. The entrant should submit a video in relevance to the theme:

"Conveying a Pocket of Hope Transportation: Its essence becoming personal, its meaning being redefined, and its foundation magnified."

- 8. In order to keep judging process blind, submitted videos cannot be watermarked or be otherwise marked.
- 9. Duration of the videos must be 3-5 minutes **ONLY**.
- 10. If using native dialect, English subtitles should be provided.
- 11. The video must not contain material that is obscene, defamatory, libelous, pornographic, and offensive or encourages conduct that would be considered a criminal offence or violates any law. Videos must be appropriate for viewing by the general public and by a multi cultural community.
- 12. The video must not contain any Public Utility Vehicles or any related businesses operated and owned by other Transport Cooperative. Entries that contain such footages shall be immediately disqualified. When disqualified, the registration fee shall not be refunded.
- 13. **ALL** material included in the video **MUST** be original and owned by the Applicant.
- 14. Entrants who should use other materials on their video should certify that they have obtained all the necessary rights including music rights, consents, authorizations, and licenses for any and all material included in applicant's video.
- 15. All winners will be given a **FREE** videography seminar and workshop with certificate.

C. ESSAY WRITING CONTEST

QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Open to all Students GRADES 9 12
- 2. A resident of the Cordillera Administrative Region

MECHANICS:

- 1. The applicant will pay a registration of Php. 100.00 per entry.
- 2. The applicant may pay by cash at the nearest CBSTC Office in their place or online through Gcash and PayMaya.
- 3. Registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferrable.
- 4. The entrant may submit multiple entries. In the event that winning entries is owned by 1 entrant, the entry with the highest score shall be considered.
- 5. Submission of entries will be from April 4, 2022 to June 1, 2022.
- 6. The essay must be **ORIGINAL**, not previously published in print or online.
- 7. Essay shall be within 1,000 to 1,500 words using English as the medium.
- 8. Format: single space, one-inch margins, Arial 12
- 9. Entrants will send a scanned copy of the entry or soft copy in PDF via email. Scanned copies must be encoded and printed on an A4 paper. It must bear the **TITLE** of the entry.
- 10. Applicant may write any title for his/her entry on the theme:

"Conveying a Pocket of Hope

Transportation: Its essence becoming personal, its meaning being redefined, and its foundation magnified."

- 11. Entrants must not write their personal information in the entry to ensure blind judging. To determine the owner of the entry, the entrants must not forget to write the **TITLE** of the entry in the Application Form.
- 12. Entrants must be the sole and exclusive author and owner of the Essay and have the full and exclusive right, power, and authority to submit the essay to the CBSTC 4th anniversary essay contest.
- 13. All winners will be given a **FREE** Essay Writing and Journalism seminar and workshop with certificate.
- 14.ALL WINNING ENTRIES SHALL BECOME PROPERTIES OF THE CORDILLERA BASIC SECTORS TRANSPORT COOPERATIVE BUT THE AUTHOR SHALL REMAIN AS THE OWNER OF THE BYLINE.
