

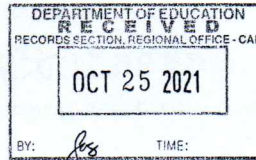

TRAINING NEED ASSESSMENT SURVEY FORM**



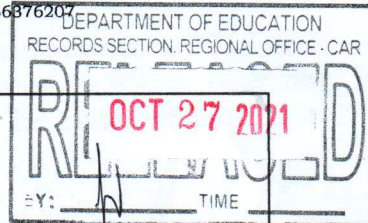
