Quiz Bee Provincial and Regional Levels for High School Students

MECHANICS:

- a. An initial quiz bee will be held in each of the provinces and the city of Baguio. Public and Private High Schools from the areas will be invited to send one representative for the provincial level competition. The date for the simultaneous provincial quiz bees is on October 18, 2018.
- b. The contestants will each be provided with answer boards which they will raise during the contest to indicate their answers. The contest will run to a maximum of one hour.
- c. The quiz bee will be multiple choice and true or false type of questions.

Questions are categorized as follows:

Level	Points per Correct Ans.	Time Limit	No. of Questions	Total Point Value
Easy	3	10 seconds	10	30
Moderate	5	10 seconds	10	50
Difficult	10	10 seconds	10	100

- d. In case of tie, additional questions will be asked until the tie is broken.
- e. In case there will be protests, judges will determine the merits. If a protest is deemed meritorious, the question will be stricken from the tally and not counted for all contestants. The judges' decision is final.
- f. Scores will be posted on tally boards that will be updated after a question is answered by all participants.
- g. Three major prizes will be given (Provincial Winners: 1st - P3,500.00, 2nd - P2,000.00; 3rd - P1,000.00) and cash incentives of P200.00 will be given to non-winners
- h. The 1st and 2nd winners of the provincial Quiz bee shall be qualified to compete in the Regional Level which is scheduled on October 30, 2018.
- i. Three major prizes will be given in the regional quiz bee (Winners: 1st - P5,000.00, 2nd - P3,000.00; 3rd - P2,000.00) and cash incentives of P300.00 will be given to non-winners

Note: Accommodation and food will be shouldered by DTI as follows:

- a. Food expenses of the students and coach/mentor who are from far flung areas
- b. One night accommodation expense of the students and coach/mentor who are from far flung areas.
