The Regional Offices are given the freedom to identify the other health, teaching, and non-teaching personnel to complete the four-member regional delegation, prioritizing those who have completed researches or documented practices on school mental health.

A crucial part of the forum is the breakout workshops where participants will discuss the mental health needs of various subpopulations in DepEd and the responses to and recommendations regarding these needs. Each of the four participants per region shall select a unique breakout workshop to join:

- Breakout Session 1: DepEd Teachers
- Breakout Session 2: Children (Kinder to Grade 4)
- Breakout Session 3: Adolescents (Grades 5 to 12)
- Breakout Session 4: Non-Teaching Personnel in DepEd Offices

To ensure the representation of all regions in all the breakout sessions, no more than one participant from one region shall attend the same breakout session. In preparation for the workshops, participants are encouraged to make necessary preparations to be able to contribute meaningfully to the discussion during the breakout workshops.

The final venue for the forum is Millenia Suites in Pasig City, where the participants will be billeted on triple-sharing, gender-segregated rooms, from October 22, 2018 (check-in starting at 2 pm) to October 25, 2018 (check-out until 12 noon). Participants may check-in at the front desk of the hotel starting at 2:00 pm, October 22, 2018, Monday. Participants will be roomed by the front desk on "first come, first served" basis.

Registration of participants and distribution of forum kits will start at 5:00 pm at the Banquet Lounge, 6th floor, while the first meal, dinner, will be served at the same venue from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. For participants who will arrive later than 8:00 pm, dinner will be packed and brought to their respective rooms. The last meal to be served is breakfast on October 25, 2018.
