PRIORITIES FOR 2020 AND 2021

In view of DepEd Memorandum No. 059, series 2019, titled "Prioritizing the Development of the Last Mile Schools in 2020-2021: Reaching Out and Closing the Gap," the following priorities are hereunder identified by the Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) and adopted in accordance to ranking for all OUA PAPs:

- 1. Last Mile Schools
- 2. Facilities Damaged by Calamities (Fire, Typhoon, Flood, Earthquake)
- 3. Abandoned and Long-Delayed Constructions
- 4. Facilities with No Clean and Potable Water
- 5. Facilities Reported Needing Urgent Repairs/Replacement by teachers, principals, supervisors, learners and employees thru DepEd Workplace

All allocations, preparations, efforts and time must be devoted and focused in addressing the needs of the five items above. These priorities take precedence over all other priorities of the department.

Aside from the provisions of facilities, all other contents like school furniture, electrical upgrades and solar panels, potable and clean water, information and communications technology (ICT) equipment and connectivity, Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) equipment, among others, must likewise follow the above priorities.
