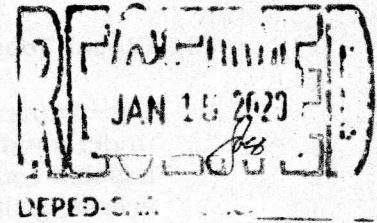



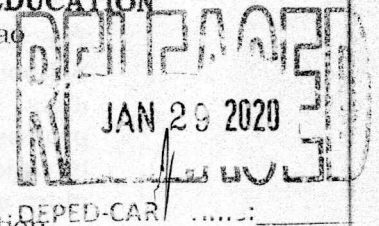

The Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) has learned about the following learning opportunities that are relevant to the implementation of some of the programs under *Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education (OK sa DepEd)*, and that may be of interest to DepEd's school health and nutrition personnel, and other personnel involved in the implementation of *OK sa DepEd* programs:

1. **The Monday Campaigns: Lessons in Public Health Promotion** (Free online course, accessible for 8 weeks from January 6, 2020)

The course provides public health professionals and other health advocates an overview of health behavior change theories; strategies for building meaningful partnerships; methods for planning, designing, disseminating, and evaluating health promotion campaigns; and free tools and resources available for use in health promotion programs that address stress, physical inactivity, healthy eating, and tobacco use. 2. **WHO QualityRights E-training on Mental Health, Human Rights and Recovery** (Free online training)

The e-training aims to improve understanding about mental health, tackle stigma and discrimination and improve the way in which services and supports are provided to people with mental health conditions or psychosocial, intellectual and cognitive disabilities. 
4. **Training for primary care providers: brief tobacco interventions** (Free online training)

5. **Global Tobacco Control Certificate Program** (Scholarship opportunity, deadline of application is on January 15, 2020)

The certificate program is part of the effort of the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health to develop global tobacco control capacity. The program aims to provide formal education to research scientists, tobacco control professionals, and graduate and post-graduate students to equip them with the technical skills necessary to play key roles in tobacco control efforts.
