CATEGORY A. (HIGH SCHOOL LEARNERS)

- Painting contest is open to 12-18 years old high school learners
- Open to all aspiring and upcoming visual artists from the Philippines- Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao from various junior and senior high schools

CATEGORY B. (GENERAL PUBLIC)

- Painting contest is open to 18 years old and above
- Open to all aspiring and upcoming visual artists from the Philippines- Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao

NOTE: Entrants should not have had any solo exhibit to be eligible to the contest.

THEME:

"THE ENVIRONMENT AND THE PRESENT TIME OF THIS PANDEMIC" TOPICS YOU CAN WORK WITH:

- Deforestation;
- Wildlife trade;
- Air and water pollution;
- Human diets;
- Climate change; and
- Other issues that fed into a breakdown of our natural systems, leading to new and fatal
- diseases, such as the current pandemic, and a breakdown of the global economy.

MAKE:

- All Artworks size should be 2ft x 2ft or 24" x 24" on canvas, paper or wood.
- Artworks will be open to water-based medium and recycled materials.
 - 1. Acrylic on canvas, paper or wood.
 - 2. Watercolor, gouache and ink on paper.
 - 3. Collage, using old magazines or prints or any relevant materials .
