Methodology:

1. The webinar series will be opened to all STEM teachers.
2. An online invitation will be sent out a week before the session to DOST regional deployment officers for the school beneficiaries and other STEM teachers in their area.
3. A preregistration portal will be setup a week before the session. Interested participants must preregister to get the evaluation/certificate after the session.
4. A 30-45 minute virtual talk will be delivered by experts from CISTEM, via Zoom Conference managed by DOST-STII. The webinar will be streamed via Facebook Live at the DOST STARBOOKS official FB page.
5. A Question & Answer portion will be allotted allowing the resource speaker to answer the first five (5) questions posted in the comment section.
6. DOST-STII will provide a Certificate of Participation to all preregistered participants and will accomplish an online quiz and evaluation/feedback form submitted not later than three (3) days after the session.

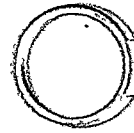
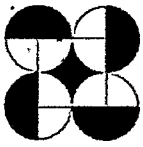

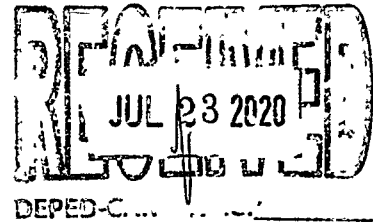
