







Greetings from the Multiple Intelligence International School Community!

We would like to invite the Department of Education **once more** to partner with and support our Youth Innovation Challenge (YIC) 2023. Given the department's pivot to quality education, putting a premium on 21st-century skills, critical thinking, and innovation, **we ask for your official endorsement to encourage the Regional Directors to invite all public and private high school students across the country to participate in this momentous event.** The conference will be conducted via Zoom on **April 28, 2023 (2:00 PM-5:00 PM) and April 29, 2023 (9:30 AM - 3:00 PM).**

The Youth Innovation Challenge is designed to provide public/private high school students the opportunity to acquire 21st-Century skills. This year's theme, "**Innovation for Sustainable Development**," aims to empower the youth to contribute to national development through creating innovative solutions to shared problems they face.

This unique challenge is the first to foster dialogue between very diverse sectors within the Philippines by way of targeting public school students from various regions and private school student leaders. We believe the Department of Education recognizes the need to create a platform to help Filipino students be globally competitive by acquiring an innovative and entrepreneurial mindset. The output from YIC 2023 will be published and given to the relevant agencies to operationalize, hoping to create a better future that has engaged the next generation as responsible stewards. YIC 2023 aims to tackle the following goals:

- 1) To introduce design thinking as a tool for capacity-building and national development;
- 2) To give students the mindset and toolset to design solutions to prevalent problems the Philippines faces, grounded in their unique contexts;
- 3) To encourage and foster dialogue to deepen understanding of sustainable development;
- 4) To foster 21st-Century skills in communication, collaboration, critical thinking, and creativity (4Cs) to be globally competitive;
- 5) To deepen an understanding of their multiple intelligences and provide a skill-building platform for students to develop an innovative and enlightened mindset to use their intelligences to Make a Difference.

As part of our advocacy to create platforms for Filipino students to be globally competitive, we will be offering DepEd schools a **special 50% discounted conference fee of PhP 500.00** instead of the regular fee of PhP 1,000.00. 

THE YOUTH INNOVATION CHALLENGE 2019

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) has received an invitation from the Multiple Intelligence International School (MIIS) for our secondary level students to participate in **The Youth Innovation Challenge 2019**, with the theme *Intelligence for Progress*. This event seeks to expose the youth to innovative thinking by giving them the opportunity to create innovative solutions to address common concerns and problems prevalent in society. The event will also have participants from private schools.
2. Moreover, the event aims to:
 - a. Introduce design thinking as a tool for capacity-building and national development;
 - b. Give students the mindset and toolset to design solutions to prevalent problems the Philippines faces, grounded in their unique contexts;
 - c. Encourage and foster dialogue to deepen understanding of sustainable development;
 - d. Foster 21st-Century skills in communication, collaboration, critical thinking, and creativity (4Cs) to be globally competitive;
 - e. Deepen an understanding of their multiple intelligences and provide a skill-building platform for students to develop an innovative and enlightened mindset to use their intelligences to Make A Difference.
3. The event will take place on **September 23, 2019**, at the **Philippine International Convention Center (PICC), Pasay City, Metro Manila**. The morning session will be devoted to talks of high-level and inspirational speakers on entrepreneurship, innovation, digital technology, and leadership. In the afternoon, there will be facilitated break-out workshops that includes mentor talk and hands-on workshops to propose innovative solutions to particular problems.
4. There will be a registration fee of **Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP2,500.00)** per student participant, with an early bird rate of **Two Thousand Pesos (PhP2,000.00)**. Given the Department's pivot of focus to quality of education, putting premium on 21st century skills, critical thinking and innovation, we encourage, on voluntary basis, the participation of select secondary level students from schools in your region, should there be available local funds, subject to existing budget and audit laws, rules and regulations. Teacher-mentors may join their students under the same terms; they will undergo parallel experts session.

5. We are enclosing the event primer, which includes the Registration Form that may be sent to yic2019@mischool.edu.ph. Please ask participating schools to submit a list of participants, if any, by the second week of September, for monitoring purposes.
