

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## **EASTWEST RURAL BANK** I RESPECT Award 2022

### **AWARD RATIONALE**

The EWRB "I Respect" Award is given to FIVE (5) graduating Grade 6 students from each DepEd Region who exemplifies the value of respect, a core value of EWRB, in his/her day-to-day dealings and encounter. The value respect can be expressed through actions such as, but not limited to:

- 1. Being courteous and polite when talking to teachers, the elderly and even to his/her
- 2. Appreciates and listens to the opinion and suggestions of those around him/her; and
- 3. Treats everyone equally and accepts that each one is unique and different
- 4. Delivers his/her tasks and responsibilities with fairness and honesty
- 5. Recognizes when he/she has done or said something unpleasant and apologizes for it

The awardee shall receive a EWRB designed medallion and a cash incentive amounting to Php5, 000.00.

### **MHO CAN JOIN?**

The EWRB "I Respect Award" is open to ALL DepEd Elementary Schools. Each school, through the School Principal, is invited to send **ONE (1) application/nominee** who the school believes best qualifies for the award.

# **QUALIFYING CRITERIA FOR AWARD RECIPIENT**

- 1. Bona fide graduating student (elementary Grade 6) of the current school year (AY 2021-2022)
- 2. Of good moral character; does not have any record or report of any inappropriate behavior or
- 3. GWA: No minimum general average is required to qualify as recipient of the award.

## **SELECTION OF NOMINEE (SCHOOL-LEVEL)**

Schools will be given the freedom to choose their nominee based on the award rationale and

#### **SUBMISSION PROCESS**

- 1. Once a nominee has been identified, school must prepare the following documents:
  - a. Personal data form with 2x2 photo (kindly see attached template)
  - b. Certificate of Good Moral Character

Note: Original documents (not scanned or certified true copy) are required

- 2. School must also prepare a **write up** to support the student's nomination as "I Respect" Award Recipient. The preparation of the write up shall be administered by the school. This means that this should be prepared by the adviser/moderator and duly noted by the Principal, and NOT by the student-nominee. The write up should answer the three questions below:
  - a. "In what ways did the student exemplify the value of respect? Cite notable instances/actions/events."
  - b. "Why did the student commit/performed these actions? What is his/her reason/motivation?"
  - c. "Why do you think this student is the most qualified to receive the I Respect Award?"
- 3. Format for the write up:
  - a. Paper size: Short/Letter (8.5" x 11")
  - b. Font type: Arial
  - c. Font size: 11
  - d. Line Spacing: 1.5
  - e. Margin: Normal, 1" all sides
  - f. The upper left of the 1st page of the write up should contain (see SAMPLE included)
    - i. Name of Nominee
    - ii. School,
    - iii. DepEd Region
  - g. MAXIMUM OF TWO (2) PAGES ONLY
- 4. All documents must be enclosed in a long brown envelope and labeled in the format below:

EWRB I Respect Award 2022

(DepEd District)
(DepEd Region)

Note: Please do not seal envelope yet since EWRB personnel will check completeness of documents upon submission

- 5. Deadline for the submission of entries/nominees is on **May 11, 2022**. School principal shall submit to EWRB personnel through:
  - a. Personal visit to EWRB Store
  - b. Pickup by EWRB personnel from the school

## **SELECTION PROCESS AND ANNOUNCEMENT OF AWARDEES**

- 1. A **PRE-SCREENING** of all submissions will be conducted. Submissions with lacking documents will automatically be disqualified.
- 2. Nominees from each region shall undergo **JUDGING PROCESS** to select the final FIVE (5) awardees from each region based on the criteria below:
  - a. Magnitude
  - b. Relevance to EWRB

c. Impact

d. Sustainability

- 3. The selected 5 awardees from each region shall be the "I Respect" award recipients for the
- A letter will be sent to the school addressed to the School Principal to inform them of the selection/non-selection of their nominees as award recipients.
- EastWest Rural Bank reserves the right not to award, and to withdraw and/or forfeit any of the award should the participants or entries fail to meet a certain competition requirement.

#### **AWARD**

The selected award recipient/s will receive the following:

1. EWRB Designed Medallion

2. Cash incentive amounting to Php5,000.00

The award will be turned over by an EWRB representative to the School Principal before the ceremony for their preparations.

### **AWARD PRESENTATION**

1. The award shall be presented to the selected recipient during the End of Year Rites of the school under the Special Awards Category

2. An EWRB representative shall accompany the school officials during the presentation of the

award to the student recipient.

3. For schools where face-to-face graduation is not allowed, the presentation of the awards shall be done during the school's virtual graduation.
