1. One of the Salient Features of RA 10533, or the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013 is the Building Proficiency through Language (Mother Tongue Based-Multilingual Education) where learners are able to learn best through their first language, their Mother Tongue. It is recognized that language play a strategic role in shaping the formative years of learners hence, basic education is to be taught in language understood by learners. Thus, Mother Tongue was included as one of the subjects from Kindergarten to Grades 1-3.

- 2. In line with the above mentioned salient feature of the law, the Department of Education Cordillera Administrative Region through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division will conduct Assessment Test on Reading Comprehension using English, Filipino and Kankanaey, the dominant Mother Tongue in the Schools Division of Benguet for the Grade 3 learners.
- 3. This activity aims to gather data in order to determine the impact of Mother Tongue Based Multi Lingual Education (MTB MLE) on students' performance on Reading Comprehension using texts written in English, Filipino and Kankana-ey as the Mother Tongue of the learners. The result of this assessment shall be the basis of preparing interventions for enhancing the MTB-MLE Curriculum in CAR.

## Guidelines on how to administer the Questionnaires:

- 1. Each class shall compose of thirty (30) learners who can **ONLY** speak and understand Kankana-ey as his/her Mother Tongue.
- 2. In case the class has less than thirty learners, you can get from the other classes in order to complete the 30 in a class but if it is more than or there are learners who can't speak the MT in a certain class you can let them join the other classes for the meantime but explain the reason of not including them in the test.
- 3. Administer the questionnaires to the same group of learners for English, Filipino and Kankana-ey. The test shall last for fifty (50) minutes for every learning area.
- 4. The three subjects shall all be administered in the morning and the schedule below must be strictly followed in all the classes administering the test. During break time, learners are not allowed to play outside except for necessity purposes only.
