The Teachers' Dignity Coalition (TDC) will be conducting the *National Seminar-Consultation on Education Policies* on August 30 to September 1, 2019 at the Benitez Hall of Baguio Teachers' Camp. With the theme "*Linking-up with the Civil Society for Stronger Education Advocacy*" the seminar's main objective is to educate our teacher-leaders on several policies of the DepEd and other national agencies and to capacitate them on policy advocacy while maximizing the partnership with several government and non-government agencies.

Some 200 teacher-leaders and school heads are invited to attend this seminar. The event is done in partnership with some Civil Society Organizations and other government agencies.
