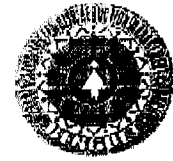

SUBJECT : Northeast Monsoon Affecting Northern Luzon

DATE : 16 December 2015

Typhoon "NONA" has slightly weakened and is now over the West Philippine Sea or 125 km Northwest of Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro with maximum sustained winds of 130 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 160 kph.

However, the Province of Benguet will continue to experience cloudy skies with light to moderate to occasionally heavy rains due to the Northeast Monsoon that is currently affecting Northern Luzon.

The Local DRRM Councils/Committees and the general public, especially those residing and working in high risk areas, are advised to take precautionary actions against possible landslides, sudden water rise along rivers, gas poisoning, cave-in and other threats to life and health that may be triggered by the current inclement weather.

The safety of everyone is our prime concern. Monitor the latest PAGASA weather updates and be guided accordingly.
