GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1. The ABRASAHAN quiz bee is open to all interested junior high and senior high school students from public and private schools. This is an individual type of competition and the number of participants per school is not limited.
- 2. A **valid school ID** is required for each contestant and a **certificate of enrollment/registration form** attesting to the qualification above (No. 1) must be attached to the registration link.
- 3. The registration fee: Package A is ₱ 100.00 per participant (Solo), Package B is ₱ 90.00 per participant (group of 5), and Package C is ₱ 80.00 per participant (group of 10), granted they have met 1st and 2nd qualifications. Payments may be sent to:



- 4. Payment should be made upon registering as the receipt should be attached to the registration link. Upon registering, proof of payment shall be sent via email.
- 5. The registration form can be filled out online at *https://tinyurl.com/ABRASAHANQuiz2023*. Participants will get an email to confirm their participation and to inform them of any additional requirements for participating in the quiz bee. All participants should register on or before May 15, 2023, at 11:59 pm. Completion of this form is highly advised for the processing of participants' e-certificates.
- 6. After registration, the participants will receive more information about the event on the Facebook page ABRASAHAN 2023, so following the page is recommended for their convenience. Also, the participants are **encouraged** to attend the webinar **ABRASAHAN** 2023: STEM Stories Beyond Clouds at 8:00 in the morning, on the same date as the Final Round of the Quiz. - 7. Participants are required to strictly follow the mechanics provided, as well as proper online etiquette.

MECHANICS

- 1. The contest shall have two (2) rounds: the **Preliminary Round** and the **Final Round**. The Preliminary Round is for all successful registered participants. The top 100 of the total participants after the Preliminary will participate in the Final Round. The Preliminary Round will be on May 27, 2023, and the Final Round will be on May 30, 2023; both rounds will commence at 1:00 P.M.
- 2. The quiz bee (both Preliminary and Final Rounds) has three levels: EASY, AVERAGE, and DIFFICULT.
- 3. Questions will come from the following areas: Algebra, Geometry, Statistics, Analytical Geometry, Trigonometry, Calculus, General Chemistry, and General Physics.
- 4. Both the preliminary and final rounds will use **Quizizz** as a platform to answer questions. In the PRELIMINARY ROUND, the quiz code will only be posted on the private group of all the participants created by the organizers and will be answered simultaneously. However, in the FINAL ROUND, Zoom Meeting will be utilized while answering the quiz as the code will now only appear in the occurring meeting. The participants must enter the meeting **30 minutes before the allocated time** to ensure that only the qualified contenders are present to answer the questions.
- 5. Participants will have to use either a desktop or laptop (the use of mobile phones is discouraged as the questions may be displayed erroneously). Participants must have their own internet or data connection and must have their camera and microphone open throughout the quiz bee.
- 6. Each participant will have their assigned CLUSTERS upon entering the Quizizz link. There will be approximately fifty (50) people in each cluster. Be aware that all questions will be the same throughout all clusters, and that will administer the quiz simultaneously.
- 7. Each participant must have paper, a pen, and a calculator for solving.
- 8. Each participant will start with a zero score at the start of Easy Level. The Final Score for the Final Ranking will be based on the accumulation of points throughout the quiz bee (Preliminary plus the Final Round scores).

9. All participants will have to wait for the signal from the Quiz Master before answering the questions.

- 10. Questions and protests from participants regarding the answer to the items will be entertained before the start of the next level. If a protest occurs, participants may address their concerns to the Quiz Master, who will convey them to the Board of Judges. The Board of Judges' decision is always final.
- 11. In case of a tie for the top 8 places, the tie will be broken through their score in Preliminary Round. The one who got the higher score will get the higher place. If they are still tied in the scores for the Preliminary Round, then the tie will be broken by the score in Final Round. If still, the tie is not broken, then a do-or-die question will be given. The first contestant who raises the correct answer to the board of judges will be considered the winner. The do-or-die question is not a multiple-choice question.
- 12. The organizers reserve the right to change all rules and guidelines for this event without prior notice. But if this kind of circumstance happens, the revised rules will be properly disseminated.
- 13. At the end of the EMSS ABRASAHAN 2023 Challenge:
 - A. Certificates of E-Participation shall be given to all the participants.
 - B. Certificates of Recognition and prizes will be given to:

Champion - Certificate of Recognition and 10,000 pesos

2nd Place - Certificate of Recognition and 7,000 pesos

3rd Place - Certificate of Recognition and 5,000 pesos

5 Consolation Prizes - 500 pesos each

(Winners will receive the prizes within 3-7 days after the event)
