
Activity Mechanics: Reading Kiosk

Activity description: Reading Kiosk is a school-level activity where students will be answering Reading Challenge using the stationed Reading Kiosks. This activity aims to encourage all learners to read during their free time.

Participants: Students from all Grade levels can participate.

Mechanics:

- 1. Participating school to station **at least 1 device** that will serve as the Reading Kiosk. Device could be a desktop computer, laptop or tablet which could be stationed in a library, computer laboratory, or reading corner.
- 2. Admin teacher to post Reading Challenge text using Reading Progress in Microsoft Teams per grade Level.
