Brief History

The Philippine Association of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities, Inc. (PAPSCU) was originally organized in 1952 and incorporated on May 8, 1956, under the name of the Philippine Association of Private Secondary Schools (PAPSS). When the Association grew, the name was changed to consider the different categories of the members. PAPSCU counts with members from the majority of the provinces. These members are wholly Filipino-owned and managed.

PAPSCU was accepted as a member of the Coordinating Council for Private Education Associations (COCOPEA) during the term of Dr. Jesus Jocson as President in 1977. The Ruby Anniversary Celebration of 40 Years was a reminder of what had been accomplished and the targets that have been yet to be achieved.

PAPSCU currently has 918 active members. With its members in strategic locations in the country, PAPSCU envisions being a significant driving force towards educational excellence and nation-building. It is committed to performing its mission as an association of private educational institutions with community impact through capacity building, advocacy, and policy research that can shape relevant educational reforms. It aims for quality, transformative education that develops ethical and responsible individuals who will lead, share, and serve the common good.

PAPSCU Empowering Education Executives in the New Reality

In support of the vision-mission of PAPSCU, the PAPSCU E3 (Empowering Education Executives in the New Reality) Project has been implemented to provide opportunities for member institutions to enhance the capabilities of their education executives in the past four years organizing 21 sessions onsite and online.

E3 in the academic year 2022-2023 was a success in conducting a mix of online and face-to-face workshops. Its seminar series "Di Pwede Ang Pwede Na! Energizing Schools with the Innovation Mindset" was its biggest physically done in three runs held in Luzon (Clark, Pampanga), Visayas (Bacolod City), and Mindanao (Cagayan de Oro City). There were a total of 1,046 attendees. The regional associations and their networks were PAPSCU's most significant asset in the success of these events. With its success in reaching out to both medium and small-sized schools, institutions, and associations, the PAPSCU E3 will continue to conduct relevant professional development programs for its members as well as other private institutions.

E3 2023-2024: DISKARTE A Schools Innovation Summit

This year's E3 will focus on action and strategy. The E3 will be a PAPSCU Schools Innovation Summit specifically targeting three key education executives in school: the school owner, the finance officer, and the academic leader. DISKARTE will focus on hurdling innovation obstacles and how schools can employ different innovation-sustaining strategies based on their contexts. PAPSCU envisions schools where innovation is the norm.
