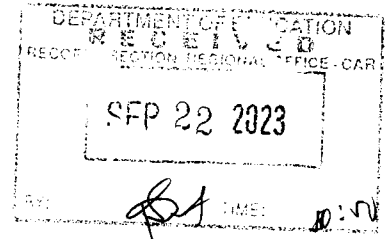



**SUBJECT : New Schedule of the 1st NELR Rover Moot**

Please be advised that the 1st NELR Regional Rover Moot to be hosted in Isabela and in Abra is rescheduled to a later date to give way for the enrollment and Brigada Eskwela activities in the host schools, the host communities and the host LGU as well, with the details and information required as follows:

1. **The Moot to be hosted in Isabela will be held at the Camp Vizcarra, Ramon, Isabela will be on 28-31 October 2023, immediately after the first grading period examination.**
2. **The Moot in Abra will be held at the University of Abra – Main Campus, Lagangilang, Abra on 27-30 September 2023.**
3. **The host LGU also requires that the Local Councils confirm the number of Rovers and Leaders, in Sex Disaggregated Data, arrival date and time for proper assistance to the camp and the immersion sites.**
4. **Local Councils must submit names of Contingent officials arriving for proper recognition during the Opening Ceremonies and for send of invite to the Camp Chief's Night.**
5. **Prepare appropriate tokens of friendship for the Camp Chief during the Camp Chief's Reception.**
6. **Local Councils must immediately organize and send contingents to the Moot in Abra and in Isabela. LC Contingents shall be assigned to one Immersion site/host school weeks before their arrival for the reception preparation like, sleeping rooms, toilets and bath, water, electricity, kitchen, and supplies and materials for the Brigada Eskwela.**
7. **The Moot in Abra shall focus on distribution of relief goods (food and clothing) to the typhoon-affected families and School Improvement activities,**



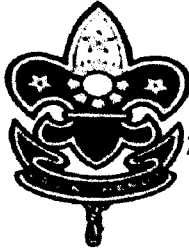

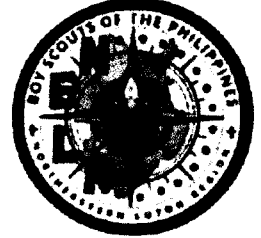

In line with the 1st NELR Rover Moot to be hosted in Isabela at the Camp Vizcarra in Ramon, Isabela, on 23-26 August 2023 and, consistent with the Scout Oath, "to help other people at all times", this region in coordination with the DepEd, Schools Division Office of Abra, has agreed to organize Rover Teams from the BSP Abra Council and from the adjacent Local Councils of Benguet, Baguio City, Kalinga-Apayao and Mountain Province to undertake community service in the typhoon affected Sitio of Saluden, Barangay Bañacao in Bangued, Abra.

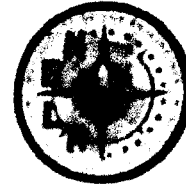

1. Pursuant to the 2023 approved Regional Calendar of Scouting Events and Observances and as approved in the RSC committee meeting on 30 June 2023, the **1st NELR VENTURE CAMP 2023** with the theme " Sustainable Growth" will be hosted in Mt. Province at the Gotang Primary School in Balintagan, Bauko, Mt. Province on 20-22 October 2023.
2. **AIMS AND OBJECTIVE.** At the end of the Venture Camp, the scouts are expected to have:
  - a) developed their full physical, intellectual, emotional, social, and spiritual capacities;
  - b) contributed to the development of a better world through experiential learning activities;
  - c) discovered, shared, and immersed in the culture and historical heritage of the host community.
3. **QUALIFICATION FOR PARTICIPANTS**
  - A. Senior scouts must be:
    1. Currently registered in the BSP as a Senior Scout;
    2. 13 years old but not over 17 years old;
    3. At least Pathfinder Rank;
    4. Physically fit and healthy as certified by the Physician,
    5. With parent's permit or consent; and
    6. With the complete set of camping gear and equipment
  - B. Adult Leaders must be:
    1. Currently registered in the BSP as Outfit Advisor;
    2. Trained and responsible for the well-being of the Scouts;
    3. Physically fit and healthy as certified by a physician;
    4. Have camping experience and of good moral character; and
    5. Have a complete set of camping gear and equipment
4. **QUOTA:** All Local Councils must organize a contingent of not less than one (1) Outfit of 36 Scouts.
5. **REGISTRATION FEE:** The registration fee is **FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500)** per participant to defray expenses for program materials, individual souvenirs, transportation of activity, and administrative costs during the event.


