CALL FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

Eligibility Requirements

- ✓ Must have at least one (1) year of teaching experience in either a public or private school, with the intent to teach as K-12 public school STEM teacher, or in the tertiary level as instructor or professor of any STEM-related subject/course (For public school K-12 teachers, priority will be given to applicants with at least two (2) years experience)
- ✓ Must be an incoming 1st year or 2nd year student in a master's degree program in education specializing in STEM, alternative learning system, tech-voc training, or special education
- ✓ Must have a general weighted average of at least 2.0 or its equivalent from the previous academic year
- ✓ Must be enrolled in a teacher education institution (TEI) within or above the national average LET performance
- ✓ Exemplifies good moral character and exhibits active participation and involvement in extra-curricular activities
- ✓ In need of financial assistance

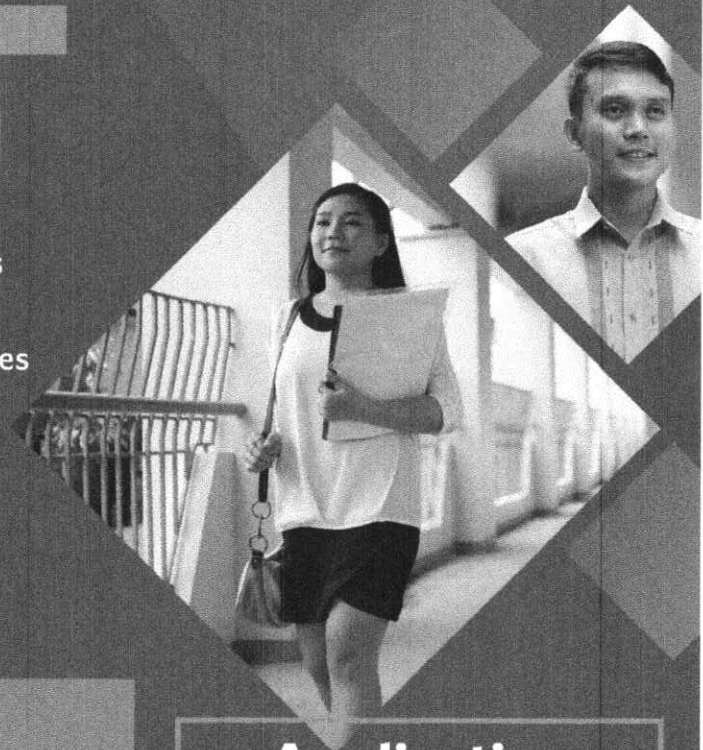
Eligibility Requirements

- ✓ Must have a general weighted average of at least 85% or its equivalent from the previous academic year
- ✓ Willing to teach in a public school in their community after graduation
- ✓ Exemplifies good moral character and exhibits active participation and involvement in extra-curricular activities
- ✓ In need of financial assistance
