Greetings from the [Fulbright Commission in the Philippines!](#)

The Philippine-American Educational Foundation (PAEF), also referred to as the Fulbright Commission in the Philippines, is a bi-national commission that administers the prestigious [Fulbright Program](#) – an international and cultural exchange program that awards scholarship grants for Filipino graduate students, young professionals, teachers, and researchers in the United States. The Fulbright program aims to increase mutual understanding and build up the bilateral relations between the people of the United States and the Philippines through study, lecturing, research, and fellowship grants. PAEF in addition, also administers the [Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program](#) and [Global Undergraduate Exchange Program](#).

We are pleased to inform you that our team will be leading and facilitating a series of information sessions (in-person) in Baguio City and we would like to invite you and attend the information session to learn more about the [U.S. scholarship and exchanges](#) that are open to all students, professionals, teachers, and researchers based in the Cordillera Administrative Region and neighboring provinces. **We would also like to ask for your assistance in disseminating this information and encourage your students, staff, and colleagues to participate as we extend our reach in promoting the Fulbright program.** Below are the exchange programs that we are presenting during this information session:

1. **FULBRIGHT FOREIGN STUDENT PROGRAM** – brings graduate students, early career professionals, artists, scientists, etc. from the Philippines to pursue studies at the graduate level (Master's or Doctoral) or non-degree doctoral dissertation research (Visiting Student Researcher) in the United States.
2. **FULBRIGHT ADVANCED RESEARCH AND UNIVERSITY LECTURING PROGRAM** – bring Filipino academics and professionals to lecture and/or conduct research in the United States.
3. **FULBRIGHT U.S. – ASEAN VISITING SCHOLAR PROGRAM** – is open to universities, foreign ministry and government officials, and professional staff of think tanks and other

NGOs in ASEAN member nations to travel to the U.S. for scholarly and professional research.

4. **HUBERT H. HUMPHREY FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM** – a Fulbright Exchange, builds connections between U.S. and foreign leaders to advanced solutions to the most pressing global challenges, from combating climate change to protecting human rights, increasing access to education, and building global health security. This program is open for mid-career level professionals for a year of combined non-graduate study and related practical and professional experiences in the United States.
5. **FULBRIGHT DISTINGUISHED AWARDS IN TEACHING PROGRAM FOR INTERNATIONAL TEACHERS** – provides high school teachers and staff with a unique opportunity to develop greater expertise in their subject areas, enhance their teaching skills, and increase their knowledge about the United States.
6. **FULBRIGHT FOREIGN LANGUAGE TEACHING ASSISTANT PROGRAM** – is a program that aims to strengthen foreign language instruction at U.S. educational institutions by establishing a native speaker presence. It is open to Filipino English teachers living outside of Metro Manila.
7. **FULBRIGHT SPECIALIST PROGRAM** – is a hosting opportunity for local institutions. It is designed to provide short-term academic opportunities for U.S. faculty and professionals to share their fields of knowledge and expertise. The FSP promotes linkages between U.S. academics and professionals and their counterparts at host institutions overseas.
8. **GLOBAL UNDERGRADUATE EXCHANGE PROGRAM** – provides a diverse group of emerging leaders and undergraduate students with a scholarship for one (1) semester of non-degree academic study at a U.S. college or university.

Here are the dates and venues for the information sessions to be held from November 14 to 15, 2023 in Baguio City. All information sessions are open to the public and it will be your choice when and where you prefer to attend. Please note that all sessions require free registration online.


