Greetings!

We are pleased to inform you that the Folk Dance Society - Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) - Baguio City Chapter is preparing to host an echo seminar of the 2023 National Philippine Folk Dance Workshop, originally held from July 26 to 31, 2023, in Bago City, Negros Occidental. Our chapter, PFDS-CAR Baguio City, will also be organizing a regional workshop scheduled for November 16 - 18, 2023 and we would like to invite you to this event.

The primary objectives of this workshop are as follows:

- foster a deeper appreciation for folk and traditional dances as powerful conduits for cultural exchange within the Philippines
- enhance the teaching competencies related to traditional Philippine dances among educators, dance instructors, choreographers, directors, performers, and dance enthusiasts;
- equip educators with valuable dance resources, including instructional videos, handouts, and more; and
- facilitate a forum for dialogue on pressing issues and concerns within the folk-dance community, involving dance educators, trainers, choreographers, and cultural arts advocates.

Participants are responsible for making their own transportation, accommodations, and meals arrangements. We will offer assistance on accommodation requests in a first-come, first-served manner in selected dormitories, hotels, and other areas within the city, particularly for participants traveling from other provinces and regions.
