Greetings!

Sipnayan, an annual mathematics competition, has been held by the Ateneo Mathematics Society (AMS) for the past 23 years. It is an opportunity for students from various schools to demonstrate their knowledge and ability in mathematics in order to encourage enthusiasm for and excellence in the subject. In its 24th year, we are once again conducting an online competition!

Sipnayan 2023 will be delivered through online platforms such as Canvas and Zoom among others. The event will also be streamed live on our official Facebook page, which can be found at facebook.com/AMSSipnayan. The competition will be separated into three divisions: (1) Grade School, (2) Junior High School, and (3) Senior High School. Furthermore, each division's competition will be divided into three stages: (i) a written elimination round, (ii) an oral semi-final round, and (iii) an oral final round. Moreover, the contest will be team-based, with groups of three people completing all of the above stages. Lastly, the registration fee for the event will be ₱300 per group. Note that there can only be a maximum of three (3) teams per division per school and that the deadline for registration for all divisions will be on March 17, 2023 6:00 PM or until slots last.





#### **General Rules: Eliminations**

- 1. The Elimination Round will be conducted on Canvas. It will be a written exam and will have a total of 21 questions. The time limit will be 2 hours.
- 2. At the end of the Elimination Round, the scores of the three contestants for each team will be added.
- 3. The top 15 teams will proceed to the Semi-final round.
- 4. Calculators are strictly prohibited.

#### **General Rules: Semifinals & Finals**

- 1. Group members should physically meet-up for Semi-Final Round
- 2. The Semi-final round will be a modified jeopardy game, and will have a total of fifteen (15) questions divided into 5 categories, with each category containing 1 easy, 1 average, and 1 difficult question. The categories will be revealed during the competition itself.
- 3. Every team will be given a chance to choose which question all the participants will answer at a given time. The order of the teams in picking the questions will be given before the round begins.
- 4. At the end of the Semi-final Round, the top five (5) scoring teams will proceed to the Final Round.
