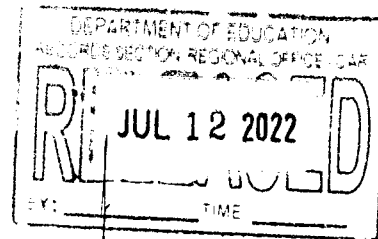

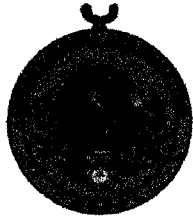

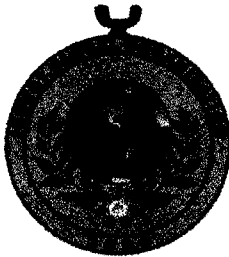

The IGO Scholarship Program (ISP) Information Sheet

I. The Igorot Global Organization and its scholarship program

1. The Igorot Global Organization (IGO) is an international association of Igorots from Abra, Apayao, Benguet, Ifugao, Kalinga, and Mountain Province. (The term Igorot was used originally to mean “people of the mountains” and has been applied variously to the indigenous inhabitants of the Cordillera region.) The IGO is registered as a non-profit organization in the USA but its members are spread out all over the world.
2. The IGO Scholarship Program started in AY 2006-07 and has since accepted and supported 76 scholars, 45 of whom already graduated as of end of AY 2018-19. Every year, the program accepts one scholar per province in CAR who will pursue their studies in institutions of higher learning in the region, preferably state universities and colleges.

II. Scholarship support and duration

1. The ISP provides financial assistance in the amount of P6,000 per semester, which is intended for any school-related expense (miscellaneous fees, books and materials, transportation, even board and lodging).
2. The grant covers the normal length of time required to finish the target course.

III. Criteria for scholarship candidates

1. a fresh graduate from a senior high school in the Cordilleras;
2. among the top ten students in the graduating class;
3. an Igorot by birth, by affinity, or by self-identification emanating from long and permanent residence in the Cordilleras;
4. must be of good moral character;
5. family is economically-constrained and has great difficulties in supporting the college education of the candidate;
6. personally committed to completing a college degree in a timely and focused fashion;
7. preferably with no other scholarship grant (either private or government);
8. must enroll in a state university or college located in CAR, unless the target course is not offered in the SUCs; and,
9. must pass the entrance examination, if any, of the school where s/he intends to enroll.

IV. Expectations from scholars as students

1. to demonstrate diligence and hard work by passing or even surpassing the grade requirements of the program, and finishing the course on schedule;
2. to be self-directed and responsible;
3. to appreciate and be proud of his/her ethnic roots and culture, including the language, tradition, stories, dances and songs, etc.; and,
4. to abide by the scholar’s responsibilities stated in the Guidelines for ISP Scholars (to be signed by the scholar once s/he is accepted).

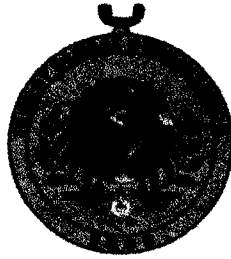
