

B. Purpose of the event

Baguio, designed by Daniel Hudson Burnham (1846-1912) in 1905, is a city with a

very unique meaning. Burnham is a master of urban planning in the United States,

and is an architect who is deeply involved in urban planning in Chicago, Los Angeles,

and Washington. He made an impact "The City Beautiful Movement" in the

Philippines, Malaysia, Australia, India, and Germany and Russia and so on. "The City

Beautiful Movement" was promoted as a result of the Industrial Revolution's public

city planning to solve the city problems of the time, and is expected to offer many

insightful solutions to the current urban problems. Therefore, by understanding the

historical significance of Baguio City, re-examining the Baguio City Plan of Burnham,

and understanding its development history, we would like to open a student-citizen

reading series to instill pride in Baguio City with this international status and seek

independent alternatives to overcome the current urban problem.
