

#### B. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING (Division and Regional Levels)

All Sabayang Pagbikas Performance videos/entries shall be judged on the following criteria:

- Relevance to the theme 40%
- Delivery (quality of voice, harmony, mastery and stage presence) 40%
- Originality-10%
- Creativity (interpretation, choreography, props) 10%

Posting of entries will be at the official facebook page of the RJJWC – CAR from November 16-20, 2022.

Judging of entries will be in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Week of November, 2022.

Awarding of top three winners will be on November 27, 2022.

- 6. The performance may only incorporate minimal choreography (i.e., hand gestures, simple formations) but must **STRICTLY** observe the guidelines on physical distancing.
- Elaborate costumes are not required and the use of simple props (i.e., hats, placards, handkerchief, cloths, masks, paper cut-outs) that are relevant to the performance are allowed.

#### **Preparing for the Entries**

To ensure the readiness of the students to participate in the contest, the Division may facilitate a structured group activity or discussion not later than 20 October 2022 to engage the students to reflect on the situation of the children in general including the children at risk (CAR) and children in conflict with the law (CICL) to share their aspirations on how duty-bearers and the public can help ensure children's rights and welfare this time of pandemic and beyond. Discussions should focus on the following general themes:

Elementary: NCM theme - "Kalusugan, Kaisipan at Kapakanan ng Bawat Bata Ating Tutukan"

 May include topics but not limited to strengthening the mental health of children; how stakeholders can implement programs and activities that will benefit the mental health of children.

Junior to Senior High School Students: JJWC Week theme – "Pagbabago ay Panigurado Kung Tutukan Natin Ang Juvenile Justice Law!"

- The importance of Republic Act No. 9344
- The student's mentor shall consider asking the following guide questions for Junior and High School:
- Ano ang kahalagahan ng Juvenile Justice Law sa inyo at sa iba pang kabataang nakararanas ng kawalang katarungan?
- Paano niyo hinarap ang pandemya?
- Paano kayo matutulungan ng batas at ng mga programa at mga gawaing tumatalakay sa pang-aabuso sa mga kabataan?
- Bilang isang bata, ano ang iyong gampanin para maipatupad ang juvenile justice law para salahat ng batang Pilipino?
- Ano ang inyong panawagan para masiguro at mapaigting ang pagpapatupad ng batas?
   Paano ito matutugunan ng pamahalaan atng mga kinauukulan?

This group activity shall be an opportunity for the students to be involved and participate in the creative process of writing the literary piece and deciding on the choreography and props to use in their performance.

The health and safety of participating students and their mentor is the top priority. The concerned school division must ensure that guidelines on proper sanitation and physical distancing are strictly observed at all times during the conduct of activities related to this activity.

#### Submission of Entries

Groups must record a video with clear audio of their delivery or performance in MP4format. The video to be submitted must be the actual raw and unedited footage of the performance of the group. No graphics is allowed in the video.

# 2022 NATIONAL CHILDREN'S MONTH and JUVENILE JUSTICE AND WELFARE CONCIOUSNESS WEEK

## Mechanics and Criteria for the Sabayang Pagbigkas Competition

As highlight of the 2022 NATIONAL CHILDREN'S MONTH and JUVENILE JUSTICE AND WELFARE CONCIOUSNESS WEEK on November 2022, the Regional Subcommittee for the Welfare of Children (RSCWC), Regional Juvenile Justice Welfare Committee (RJJWC), and Regional Committee Against Trafficking - Violence Against Women and Children (RCAT VAWC) are holding a Sabayang Pagbigkas¹ or Speech Choir Activity based on the event's theme (NCM theme: "Kalusugan, Kaisipan at Kapakanan ng Bawat Bata Ating Tutukan"; JJWA Week's theme: Pagbabago ay Panigurado Kung Tutukan Natin Ang Juvenile Justice Law!). The activity is a good platform for children and youth to convey their messages and persuade the audience on their call for action.

Specifically, the activity aims to provide opportunity for children and youth to showcase their talents in writing and delivering their literary pieces, communicate to all stakeholders and duty-bearers their call for action, and create awareness among audiences about their stories of hope.

#### A. MECHANICS

- 1. The Sabayang Pagbigkas Activity is open to all Elementary and from Junior to Senior High School Students. Only one (1) group/one (1) entry per division is allowed.
- 2. The Group must have at least minimum of five (5) and maximum of ten (10) members, open to all gender, age 10 to below 18 years old.
- 3. The literary piece (poem) to be recited must be in Filipino, written/composed by the group, and should focus on the theme:
  - Elementary: NCM theme "Kalusugan, Kaisipan at Kapakanan ng Bawat Bata Ating Tutukan"
  - Junior to Senior High School Students: JJWC Week theme "Pagbabago ay Panigurado Kung Tutukan Natin Ang Juvenile Justice Law!"
- 4. The literary piece shall not contain blasphemous, profane, crude and discriminatory language.
- 5. The performance must be at least three (3) minutes but must not exceed six (6) minutes, exclusive of entrance and exit.
