**(Writers are advised to get as much information on the events before coming to the workshop)**

- Apayao (Danilo Cudiamat): Institutionalizing LRMDs- from strong community engagement, to community research, to materials production (indigenized curricula and teacher's guides) to quality assurance (LR process at the DO level)
- Kalinga (Ramonchito Soriano): institutionalizing platforms of cooperation – from framework formulation between DepED Kalinga and Kalinga elders, discussing IPED with other stakeholders (govt agencies, NGOs and other groups), culminating in the **Ullalim** which formalized the social contract between DepED Kalinga and the Kalinga ICCs for IPED, and the MOAs of DeED Kalinga with various offices highlighting their support for IPED as a provincial endeavor.
- Benguet (Emy Faustino): Refining the Training process. The only Division to hold a separate orientation for the school heads of both elementary and secondary schools in preparation for the Division-wide retooling held in Nov 2014.
- Abra (Emma Segundo): Articulating the Indigenous Learning Systems (ILS) of the Abra ICCs
- MP-(Annie Wallang) Story of Pedro Morareng on Momma; or any available stories (council of elders, community elders)
