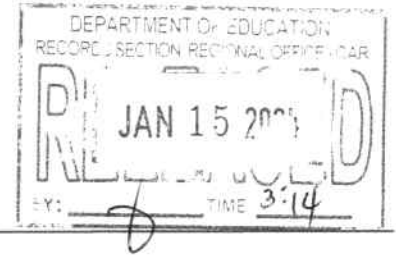

This is in reference to the discontinuation of the senior high school (SHS) program in state universities (SUCs) and local universities and colleges (LUCs), as provided for by Section 32, Rule VII of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of *Republic Act 10533* or the *Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013*.
2. In order to mitigate the displacement of learners and ensure their seamless transfer to other public and private schools, **affected Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are directed to collaborate with SUCs and LUCs to devise mechanisms and transition plans for the said undertaking.**
3. To aid the creation of SDO Transition Plans, this Office provides the current SHS enrollment data and indicators of SUCs and LUCs for SY 2023-2024 and a list of possible schools where displaced Grade 11 learners can be transferred for SY 2024-2025 that you can access through this link **<https://bit.ly/AbsorptiveCapacity>**. SDOs are encouraged to identify additional public and private schools that may serve as possible receiving schools, taking into consideration the absorptive capacities to maintain optimal ratios and other applicable indicators.

4. SDO Transition Plans must be submitted to the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Operations (OASOPS - Field Operations) via email at asec.ops@deped.gov.ph not later than **January 31, 2024**, duly endorsed by the Regional Director.
