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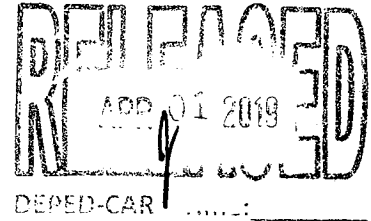

C. Observations/Comments/Suggestions/Recommendations


- For the Delegation Management
 1. Coaches should instill discipline and sense of camaraderie in their sports program. Coaches should serve as role model to their athletes
 2. Strengthen their sports program through partnerships with stakeholders
 3. Allowances of athletes and coaches should be given on time
 4. Measurement of delegation uniforms to be strictly followed
 5. Orient members of the different committees on their roles and functions prior to the start of the event

- For the Host Division
 1. Billeting quarters should not be too far from the playing venues
 2. There should be adequate and clean water supply

- For the Regional Management Team
 1. On Officiating
 - To continuously check on the accreditation of officiating officials in order to avoid unclear, bias or unfair judgment
 - If possible to equally distribute the number of officiating officials to the different divisions
 2. On Medical Concerns
 - Provision of medicines for basic illness such as diarrhea,
