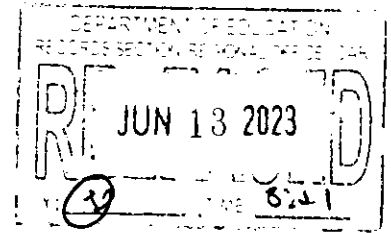

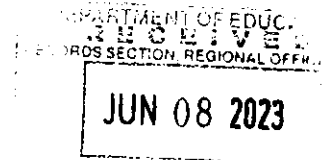

The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) in coordination with the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) will conduct the **Capability Building of Alternative Learning System (ALS) Teachers on Beginning Reading** from June 27 to 30, 2023 at Hotel Vivo in Baguio City, Benguet.

This activity aims to:

1. capacitate ALS teachers in teaching beginning reading;
2. identify effective and efficient teaching strategies applicable to ALS beginning reading; and
3. nurture a culture of reading in all ALS Community Learning Centers (CLC).

Board and lodging and other expenses for supplies and materials will be charged to the 2023 FLO-ALS Fund while travel and other incidental expenses will be charged to the funds comprehensively downloaded to the Regional Offices per OASALS-OM-2023-015 entitled "Fiscal Year 2023 Alternative Learning System Funds Directly Released to the Regional Offices," and will be paid in full upon submission of the travel documents, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Downloading of funds to the participants' respective Schools Divisions Offices is highly encouraged when deemed necessary and applicable. In case the downloaded funds are not sufficient to cover the actual expenses incurred, Program Support Fund (PSF) FY 2023 or local funds will be utilized to augment the reimbursement of the said expenses.



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Participants shall observe the time-on-task policy based on DepEd Order (DO) No. 9, s. 2005, *"Instilling Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith."*
