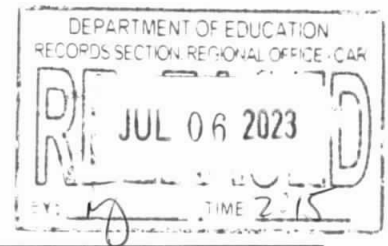

**CONDUCT OF ACTUAL SURVEY ON THE POLICY ANALYSIS OF THE K TO 12
ASSESSMENT FOR QUALITY REFORM EFFORTS**

1. Pursuant to Memorandum OM-CI-2023 dated May 16, 2023, the Philippine Normal University (PNU) will conduct the actual survey on the policy analysis of the K to 12 Assessment for quality reform efforts involving DepEd personnel as part of the data collection. This involves a survey for teachers, school heads and supervisors on their understanding and use of the different assessment policies issued in the period of the K to 12 classroom assessment, national assessment in 2016, system assessment in 2017, and the interim assessment in 2020.
2. This activity aims to determine how assessment policies in the K to 12 program contribute to quality basic education in the Philippines.
3. In connection to this, all Schools Division Offices are encouraged to identify respondents through the Division Research Coordinators. The guideline in the selection and distribution of the respondents is enclosed in this memorandum. **GUIDELINES IN THE SELECTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF
ACTUAL STUDY RESPONDENTS**

1. The conduct of the final survey will start on July 7 and ends on July 15, 2023. Each respondent will accomplish the survey form(in excel file) sent by the division research coordinators.
2. Once the respondents have completed the survey form, they will upload it directly to the repository assigned to them (Repository for teachers, for school heads and for supervisors). The link for the repositories will also be sent to the division research coordinators.
3. A separate repository for monitoring will be provided to the Regional Research Team.
4. The responses of the respondents will be treated with confidentiality, and these will only be used for policy research and the identity is concealed when the results are reported.

A. Teacher Respondents

1. Respondents in the study must be in service or in their current capacities since 2015.
2. Teacher respondents must have taught English, Science, or Mathematics regardless of their Baccalaureate specialization.
