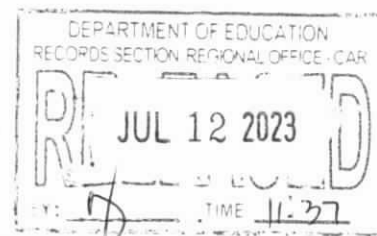

ROLL OUT OF DEPED CAR TEACHING WITH IMPACT (INSTITUTING MODERN PEDAGOGY AND CREATIVE TEACHING) PHASE 1-BATCH 2

1. Pursuant to DM-OUHROD-2023-851 covering the implementation of Professional Development Programs aligned with the priority programs of the Curriculum and Teaching (CT) Strand anchored on the MATATAG Education Agenda, this Office shall conduct the **DEPED CAR TEACHING WITH IMPACT** in the SDOs in different batches.
2. This professional development shall develop essential competencies of master teachers to guarantee that they are properly equipped to implement the K to 12 Program as they gear towards being Distinguished Teachers (Career Stage 4).
3. Specific objectives of the training are:
 - a. Prepare workplace application plan to showcase exemplary teaching strategies as well as effective and constructive behavior management skills that promote learner achievement across learning areas;
 - b. Create an inventory of effective strategies in the planning and management of developmentally sequenced teaching and learning processes in varied teaching contexts for provision to teachers in Career Stage 1 to 2; and
 - c. Illustrate the process of designing, adopting and implementing teaching strategies that are inclusive and responsive to learners with disabilities, giftedness and talents.
4. Relative to the approval from the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) per **Program Accreditation No. PTR-2022-390-2843** for 15 CPD units, the implementation for SDO Benguet is scheduled on **July 28 to August 2, 2023** at Brentwood Apartelle, Baguio City.
5. Enclosure 1 lists the participants, training management, and resource speakers.
6. All participants shall take the required pretest via **<https://tinyurl.com/CARteachIMPACT>** before July 28, 2023. Moreover, participants shall complete all activity requirements to be granted 15 CPD units.
7. In the event that endorsed participants are not able to join the activity, due to unavoidable circumstances, the SDO shall provide a replacement participant before July 28, 2023.
