 - A. determine priority improvements areas in the region and divisions through the analysis of performance indicators. (input to RO and SDO's Annual Implementation Plan for CY 2024)
 - B. monitor financial and physical accomplishments of SDOs for the first semester as bases for plan adjustment for the second semester.

4. Next steps

2nd Quarter Regional Monitoring, Evaluation and Adjustment (RMEA) INSTRUCTIONS

The 2nd Quarter RMEA is designed to articulate evaluation data that serve as necessary inputs in the development of AIP for FY 2024 and catch up/adjustment plans for the 3rd and 4th of FY 2023. The objectives for which the conference aims to achieve are the following:

- determine priority improvements areas in the RO and SDOs through the analysis of performance indicators. (input to RO and SDO's Annual Implementation Plan for CY 2024);
- monitor financial and physical accomplishments of SDOs for the first semester as bases for plan adjustment for the second semester.

To ensure the attainment of the objectives, the following instructions must be considered:

- A. Pre-Work
- 1. Analysis of Key Performance Indicators (Results Evaluation)

SGOD through the SMME Section and in cooperation with the Research and Planning Section shall analyze the KPIs for the last three years (SY 2019-2020, SY 2020-2021, 2021-2022) using the following methods: a) comparison of actual accomplishments vs. targets; b) historical or trend analysis; c) benchmarking.

Guide Questions:

- In what KPI did the SDO attain or surpass its targets? What PPAs are implemented vis-à-vis these accomplishments?
- What KPIs are below the targets set? What programs and projects are currently implemented to address these?
- Conduct causal analysis of the indicators and determine the critical segments.
 - e.g. high school leaver rate significantly contribute to low completion rate in Junior High Schools. They are most prevalent in schools A, B, C, D, E, F, etc.
- Historical Analysis: What trends are favorable? Alarming? Why? If these trends will continue, what will likely happen?
- Comparison with Benchmarks: How is the SDO performance compared with regional and national benchmarks?
- What are the priority improvement areas of the Division? What plan adjustments should be done?

- Evaluation of accomplishments vs. targets for the First Semester of FY 2023.
 Using the accomplished Table, SGOD through the SMME Unit shall evaluate accomplishments of the Division vis-à-vis the targets set in the AIP/ WFP. (GAS, PSF; current and continuing)
 - What targets are attained? (physical, financial and schedule.)
 - o What are the gaps/variances?
 - What are the operational concerns that contribute to these gaps? (competencies, resources, policy gaps, planning, evaluation and monitoring, controlling, rewarding, etc)
 - O How can these gaps/ variances be addressed for the second semester? (Catch up plan)
 - What mechanisms should be put in place to facilitate the implementation of these PPAs?

B. PRESENTATION (RMEA Proper)

- 1. The ASDS or the SGOD Chief should do the presentation on behalf of the SDO.
- 2. There shall be 2 rounds of presentation with the following specifications:
 - a. Presentation of Analysis of KPIs of the region and SDOs
 - maximum of 10 slide decks (dashboard) to presented in 10 minutes
 - presentation should be more focused on the results of analysis and evaluation of data and less on table reading.
 - assigned panel of reactors (preferably SDS) will ask queries or give comments or recommendations – 10 minutes
 - b. Presentation of Analysis of M&E Data by the SDOs. (Accomplishments vs. targets as reflected in the AIP / WFP)
 - maximum of 10 slide decks (dashboard) to presented in 10 minutes
 - presentation should be more focused on the results of analysis and evaluation of data and less on table reading.
 - assigned panel of reactors (preferably SDS) will ask queries or give comments or recommendations – 10 minutes
- 3. Outputs of RMEA will serve as inputs to the planning process. Hence, Planning and Research Section of the SGOD are enjoined to attend the RMEA and they are expected collaborate with SMME Section in the preparation of DMEA reports.
- 4. RMEA and DMEA reports shall be compiled and consolidated to serve as reference for the planning workshops.
