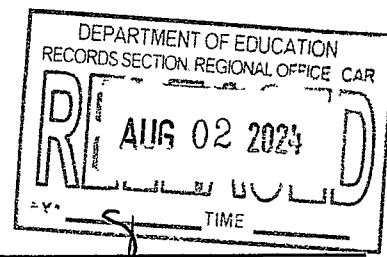

1. The Department of Education Cordillera Administrative Region through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division in coordination with the Education Support Services Division will conduct a **quiz bee and poster-making contest activities** at the DepEd CAR Regional Office, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet on August 30, 2024, with the theme: **“ASEAN: Enhancing Connectivity and Resilience”** to commemorate the Foundation of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) by virtue of Presidential Proclamation No. 282 dated July 31, 2018 declaring the month of August as **ASEAN Month**.
2. The objectives of the activities are as follows:
 - a. expose learners to ASEAN cultural, political, and social information;
 - b. foster the spirit of healthy competition among ASEAN youth;
 - c. recognize the creative artistry of Filipino learners; and
 - d. provide an avenue to hone the critical thinking skills of learners.

Accommodation and meals during the competition will be charged to the downloaded ASEAN-UNESCO 2024 Information Drive Program Support Funds while travel and incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to available local funds subject to usual accounting rules and regulations. Guidelines for the ASEAN Month Celebration Contest Events

A. ASEAN QUIZ BEE

The student participants in the Regional Level Competition must:

- a. be in Grades 9 or 10, between 15-17 years old;
- b. come from either a public or a private school;
- c. be proficient in the English language, both oral and written;
- d. have an average grade of 85 and above in Araling Panlipunan/Social Studies during the School Year 2023-2024;
- e. have good interpersonal skills/be a good team player; and
- f. meet other criteria that may deemed necessary by the ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee.

Quiz Mechanics for the Competition Proper

- a. The eight (8) participants from the eight (8) SDOs shall compete individually in two segments.
- b. The two (2) segments are as follows:
 - Segment 1: **True or False and Multiple Choice**
 - Segment 2: **Fill in the blanks or Completion**
- c. Segment 1: The TRUE or FALSE part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given one (1) point. The MULTIPLE CHOICE part will have 10 questions. Each correct answer will be given one (1) point. **The Total Score is 20 points.** Participants will be given **10 seconds** to write down their answers.
- d. Segment 2: The FILL IN THE BLANKS or COMPLETION will have 20 questions. Each correct answer will be given three (3) points. **The Total Score is 60 points.** Participants will be given 15 seconds to write down their answers. A buzzer/bell shall indicate that time is up. Answers should be written in full, with no abbreviations or acronyms. Articles and prepositions should be correct. Answers with wrong spelling will be considered wrong. Corrections may be made by the participants, but the previous answers must be fully erased or fully crossed out within the given time.
- e. The total points for the competition is 80.
- f. Each participant will be provided with writing materials where the participants will write their answers.
- g. Each question in Segments 1 and 2 will be read twice. After the quizmaster reads the question the second time, he/she will say "**GO**", only then the participants will write their answers. When the time is up, the Quizmaster will say "Markers Up", Participants will hold their markers up and their answers. The Quizmaster will read aloud the answers of each participant. The Scorers will record the answers accordingly. A cumulative score per participant will be announced by the Quizmaster after each round before going on to the next segment.
- h. In case of a tie, tie breaker question/s shall be asked until definite winner/s emerge. At the start of a tiebreaker round, the scores revert to zero.

- i. Should there be questions or protests, the Board of Judges shall decide on the matter. Their decision is final.
- j. The Chairman shall declare the winners.

B. POSTER-MAKING CONTEST

Event Rules and Mechanics

1. There will be two categories for the poster-making contest.
 - a. **Category A: Elementary Level from Key Stage 2 (Grade 4-6)**
 - b. **Category B. High School Level category from either Key Stage 3 (Grade 7-10) or Key Stage 4 (Grade 11-12)**
2. The Poster-making is an on-the-spot event.
3. Entries should follow the theme: **“ASEAN: Enhancing Connectivity and Resilience**
4. Only one (1) learner-participant per category from each SDO is allowed to join.
5. Learner participants are given four (4) hours to finish their output.
6. Participants may use oil pastels, crayons, or watercolors as a medium for poster-making.
7. Participants are not allowed to bring pictures or images as references to their entries.
8. Participants must come on time. However, late participants shall still be accommodated but time shall not be extended.

Interpretation of the theme (Relevance)	40%
Difficulty (Technique)	15%
Overall impression of the art (Artwork on its own as a complete and outstanding work of art)	20%
