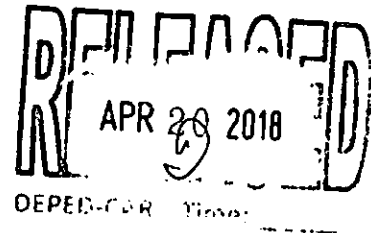

PARTICIPANTS FOR THE NATIONAL TRAINING OF TRAINERS (NTOT) ON PRIMALS PLUS FOR JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL FOCUSED ON ENGLISH, FILIPINO, MATHEMATICS, AND SCIENCE

1. To ensure the attainment of the goal to provide quality basic education to Filipino learners, the department of education, through the Bureau of Learning Delivery-Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD) in partnership with the Basic Education Sector Transformation (BEST) Program, will conduct the **Pedagogical Retooling in Mathematics, Languages (English and Filipino), Science plus AP, EsP, MAPEH and TLE for Junior High School (PRIMALS PLUS for JHS)**.
2. The purpose of this program is to develop among Grades 7 to 10 (Key Stage 3) teachers the following: a.) enhanced content knowledge, pedagogical skills, and, and attitudes; b) improved ability to improve to assess learners' various literacy skills; and c) sustained commitment in mentoring and sharing of teaching practices and experiences through a cost-effective and sustainable professional development system to improve instruction and learning outcomes.
3. The National Training of Trainers (NTOT) on PRIMALS PLUS for Junior High School (focused on English, Filipino, Mathematics, and Science) is scheduled on May21-25, 2018 at Makati City, NCR, while NTOT on PRIMALS PLUS for Junior High School (focused on AP, EsP, MAPEH, and TLE) is to be announced soon.
