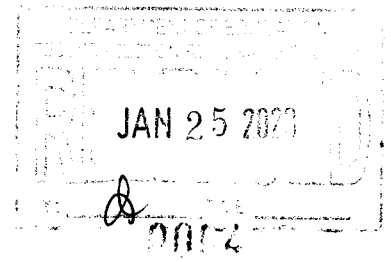

Pursuant to Republic Act Nos. 4670, 10533 and 9155 corollary to Civil Service Memorandum Circular No. 3, s. 2012, DepEd Order No. 11, s. 2019 and 001, s. 2020, with the mandate to implement programs for Professional Development (PD), the National Educators Academy of the Philippines-Central Office has engaged with the Philippine Normal University (PNU) with the implementation of the LiSqUP, a two-year customized program aligned with the sets of DepEd-adopted professional standards.
