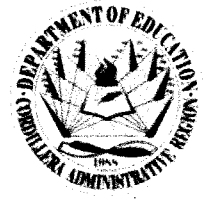

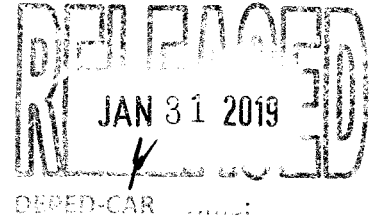

**2019 CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION
ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (CARAA) MEET**



**To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Divisions
All Others Concerned**

1. Consistent with Republic Act 10588 or the Palarong Pambansa Act of 2013 and other existing DepEd policies on the development and strengthening of the school sports program, the 2019 Cordillera Administrative Region Athletic Association Meet or CARAA with the theme, "One Team, One Vision," shall be held on February 27 to March 3, 2019 at the Apayao Eco-Tourism and Sports Complex in Luna, Apayao.
2. The annual regional sports event shall be hosted by the Provincial Local Government Unit of Apayao with the Schools Division Office (SDO) of Apayao.
3. The screening and evaluation of athlete's documents shall be on February 20-22, 2019 at the Schools Division Office of Apayao, Luna, Apayao. Members of the RSAC (Regional Screening and Accreditation Committee) from the Schools Division offices must be at the venue on February 19, 2019. Interview of athletes shall be from February 23 to 25, 2019. Failure to comply with the submission schedule will automatically disqualify the concerned athlete/s or teams to participate in the 2019 CARAA. (Regional Memorandum No. 38, series 2019)
4. To ensure the smooth organization, coordination, conduct, and promotion of the regional sports event, attached is the list of the permanent composition of the CARAA Board and the duly constituted technical management and working committees and its respective functions (Enclosure 1).
5. This CARAA 2019, Tabuk City and hereafter shall be a separate delegation from Kalinga Province, rounding up a total of eight (8) participating division delegations for the annual regional sports event.
6. To further promote CARAA 2019 and boost the morale of participants through identity, the following shall be the official monikers of the participating divisions. As such, monikers may be included in the design of uniforms as well as in the banners, streamers, and other signage during the opening and closing programs including in the billeting centers:

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7. As espoused by the K to 12 Basic Education Program and in support of the holistic development of learners including the advocacy of important policies to DepEd personnel, a Life Skills Camp, an innovative inclusion to the CARAA activities will be done in the billeting centers/schools by the delegations' youth formation officers/coordinators led by the Regional Office's Education Support Services Division. Details will be discussed in a separate Memorandum.
8. The Olympic Medal System shall be applied to determine the overall champion and rankings. Hence, ranking shall be based on the total number of gold, silver, and bronze medals to be contested in the different sports events.
9. Dance Sports, Pencak Silat, and Aerobics Gymnastics shall be regular events in the regional level and its results shall be included in the official medal count earned by the division delegation.
10. In line with DepEd's existing policies and guidelines in resolving protest on game technicalities of any sports event and protest on eligibility, complaints should be in written form, duly affidavits of witnesses and/or evidence to support the same and shall be filed before the start of the second game of the concerned team. There shall be no protest fee to be collected from the protesting division delegation.
11. All selected officiating officials are required to attend the opening and closing programs, and the Refresher Course. Those who fail to register and attend the Refresher Course shall be replaced by the Regional Screening Committee for Sports Officiating Officials following the criteria set forth in the selection. The List of Tournament Managers and Sports Officiating Officials shall be announced in a separate memorandum.
12. The Search for the Most Disciplined and Most Organized Delegation, Best Billeting Center, and the Cleanest, Greenest, and Eco-Friendliest Delegation shall continue to be implemented. The winners shall receive a cash prize of PhP 10,000 each from the Regional Office and Plaques of Recognition courtesy of the host PLGU.
13. In compliance with DepEd Order No. 13, series 2017 entitled Policy and Guidelines on Healthy Food and Beverage Choices in Schools and in DepEd Offices, all delegations shall promote healthy eating habits by making available healthy and nutritious food and beverages during the CARAA 2019.
14. All division delegations shall be accountable for the protection, welfare, and safety of their pupil/student-athletes in adherence to DepEd Order No. 40, series 2012 or the DepEd Child Protection Policy. Moreover, all division delegates shall observe the integration of the principles of gender equality, gender equity, gender sensitivity, non-discrimination and human rights as per DepEd Order 32, series of 2017 or the Gender-Responsive Basic Education Policy.
15. Schools Division Offices are also expected to provide all athletes with learning interventions as part of their academic program to compensate for missed lessons. Likewise, school heads concerned shall take responsibility in assigning competent teacher/s to handle the affected classes in compliance with the 180 days non-negotiable teacher-pupils/students contact time.
16. Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Trainers, Officiating Officials, and members of division and regional technical working committees shall observe the No Alcohol, No Smoking, and No Gambling policies of DepEd. Violators shall be dealt with accordingly.

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17. Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Chaperons, Trainers, Delegation Officials, Officiating Officials, and Members of the Technical Working Group Committees who will render services during weekends shall be given Service Credits and Compensatory Overtime Credits (COCs) for the non-teaching personnel based on the actual services rendered prior to and during the 2019 CARAA meet. The Schools Division Superintendents shall issue special order on service credits/COCs in their respective divisions and the same to regional office personnel, officiating officials and technical working committee members by the Regional Director.
18. The Regional Office will provide caps, t-shirts, *chaleco* or vests, meals and transportation allowances of the officiating officials and members of the technical management and working committees subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
19. On top of the allowable expenses to be given to the officiating officials and members of the various management and working committees, an additional supplemental allowance to cover the cost of bottled water, toiletries, medicines, and such other related types of expenses may be authorized subject to the accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

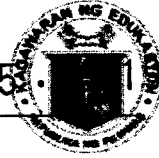

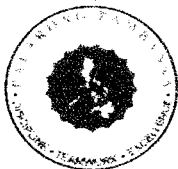
