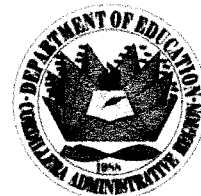

Subject: **Participation to the Enabling Writers' Training in Mother-Tongue Based Multilingual Education (MTB-MLE)**

Date: **February 13, 2017**

1. The University of San Jose-Recoletos College of Education-Cebu City, in partnership with the Department of Education-CAR, and Saint Louis University-Baguio City, will conduct the Enabling Writers' Training on Mother Tongue-Based Multilingual Education to thirty (30) public school teachers in the elementary who are adept in the Kalanguya language on **March 16 to 19, 2017 (Thursday to Sunday)** at the **NEAPR, DepEd-CAR Compound, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet.**
2. This activity primarily aims to improve the reading proficiency levels of early graders by developing decodable and leveled books following the MTB-MLE principles and LRMDS guidelines, using the Bloom software. The thirty teachers shall produce 10 decodable and leveled books each for validation and field testing.
3. The USJ-R COE along with SLU and DepEd-CAR shall produce the books created by the trained teachers to be distributed as learning resource materials, sponsored by the United Research Co. (URC) and the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), duly copyrighted by Creative Commons Licensing.

5. Participants are required to bring laptop, extension cord, and other ICT gadgets useful for the training.
6. First meal will be breakfast of Thursday, March 16 and the last meal will be dinner of Sunday, March 19. Lodging of all participants will be at the NEAPR Dormitory.
7. Expenses for board and lodging of participants will be charged to the University of San Jose-Recoletos-College of Education (USJ-R COE) while travelling and other incidental expenses will be charged to local/MOOE funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Teacher participants will be entitled to service credits for two days in lieu of Saturday and Sunday (March 18 and 19) in accordance to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 and DepEd Order No. 19, s. 2011. On the other hand, non-teaching personnel from the Division and Regional Offices who will be involved in this activity will be granted with CTO as per CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004.
