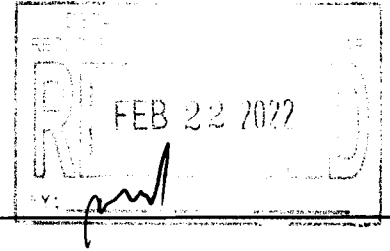

**REGIONAL ONLINE CONTEST IN ENGLISH AND FILIPINO
 CUM PROJECT READ TO LEAD**

1. The Department of Education – Cordillera Administrative Region (DepED-CAR) Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall conduct the **Regional Online Contest in Story Reading for Grades 5 & 6 both in English and Filipino on March, 2022.**
2. The objectives of this activity are to:
 - a. Provide opportunity for Grade 5 & 6 learners to demonstrate their verbal proficiency through story telling; and
 - b. Increase children’s willingness to communicate their thoughts and feelings.
3. SDOs shall conduct a Division-wide Online Story Telling contest following the mechanics stipulated in paragraph 5. First Place winners for each required grade level in English and Filipino shall qualify for the regional level online contest. Each SDO shall submit only two (2) entries or contestants, distributed through the table below:

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4. Said activity is open to both public and private school learners who are enrolled for School Year 2021-2022.
5. Please be guided by the contest mechanics specified below:
 - a. The contestant is free to choose a story, written in either English or Filipino language.
 - b. Story reading to last for 5 minutes including the entrance and exit.
 - c. Costumes and props are not required. Contestants must be in casual clothes or in school uniform.
 - c. Entries will be submitted through a video. Videos should have a minimum resolution of 720p (16:9) to optimal 1080p (16:9) and may be saved in .wmv, .mov, .mp4, or .mpg file formats before submitting through the online google form through this link: <https://tinyurl.com/R2LEng5andFil6>
 - e. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:

Delivery (Pronunciation, Articulation and Intonation)	25%
Fluency (Voice Expression, Proper Phrasing, Speed, Voice Quality)	25%
Timing, Pacing, Projection	20%
Performance (Level of Confidence, Eye Contact)	20%
Time Management	10%
