

1. In line with DepEd Memorandum No. 030, s. 2018 on the Conduct of the 8th ASEAN Quiz National Competition, the Department of Education Cordillera Administrative Region through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division will conduct the Regional Level ASEAN Quiz on March 15, 2018 at the SNC Hall, DepEd-CAR Regional Office, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet.
2. The Regional Level ASEAN Quiz intends to foster the spirit of healthy competition among our students from the Eight Divisions in a friendly quiz bee that exposes them to ASEAN cultural, political, economic, and social information, and to select the best quizzier who will represent our region to the national level competition.
3. The Participants to this activity are the 8 winners of the Division Level ASEAN Quiz, their respective coaches and their respective SDO's Araling Panlipunan Education Program Supervisors. The Quizmaster and proctors will come from the CLMD of the Regional Office.
4. The student-participants in the Regional Level Competition should meet all the following requirements (DepEd Memo N0. 030, s. 2018, page 2):
 - a. Must be in grades 9 to 10, between 15 to 17 years old and must not be 18 years old by time of the competition in Indonesia;
 - b. Must come from either a public or a private school;
 - c. Must be proficient in English language both oral and written;
 - d. Must have a grade of 85 and above in Social Studies during the first quarter of School Year 2017-2018;
 - e. Must be physically fit;
 - f. Must have good interpersonal skills/good team player;
 - g. Must be willing (with parental consent) to travel for the competition;
 - i. Must meet other criteria that may be deemed necessary by the ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee Philippines.
5. Rules and mechanics of the National Level Competition (Enclosure N0. 3 to DepEd Memorandum No. 030, s. 2018) shall be adopted for this contest.
6. Morning snack and lunch during the day of competition shall be charged against the Regional Office's MOOE, while lodging, transportation expenses and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
