1. Relative to the issuance of DepEd Memorandum No. 57, s. 2016 ADMINISTRATIVE MEETING WITH REGIONAL TRAINING TEAMS ON THE CAPACITY OF SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SHS) TEACHERS FOR THE K TO 12 BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAM, the original 643 DepEd-CAR data on SHS teachers allocation were increased to 1136 SHS teachers allocation. In this regard, this office computed the distribution per division allocation of the increased 493 (refer to Table 3) in reference to Table 2.

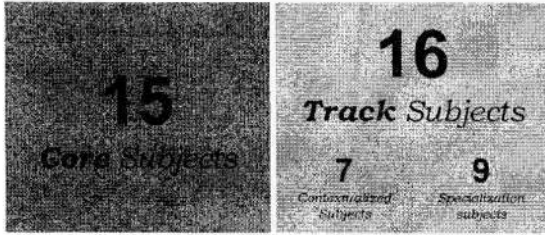
