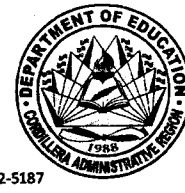

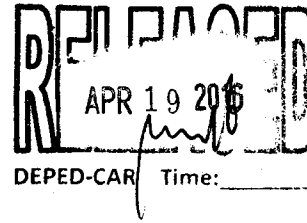

The participants in the aforementioned activity shall comprise the pool of trainers for the Mass Training of Teachers – Common Topics and TVL Track. Attached, for reference, are the summary of the number of participants by region (Attachment 1).

In this regard, the Regional Directors are advised to prioritize the said NTOT over other activities of the Regions.

Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants in the activities shall be downloaded to the Regions, chargeable against HRTD Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Likewise, all participants are requested to observe the following:

1. Take the cheapest means of transportation to and from the venues.
2. Attend the Opening Program. Those who fail to attend the Opening Program shall not be accepted unless there is a valid reason for the late arrival.
3. Present their authority to travel signed by the Regional Director or Asst. Regional Director. Those who are not in the confirmed list of participants shall only be accommodated if endorsed by the Regional Director or the Asst. Regional Director.
4. Bring their own laptops to the activity.

5. Attend all sessions on time. Early leavers and participants who fail to submit the training outputs shall only receive certificates of appearance and shall not be allowed to participate in the MTOT as trainers.
6. Come in proper attire and observe proper decorum throughout the duration of the training.

Reminders for the NTOT participants of the **General/Common Topics**:

1. Regions are requested to advise the participants to pre-register on-line at www.deped.in/ntot2016registration on or before April 21, 2016.
2. Included in the allocation of participants per region are the Regional Management Team composed of the HRDD, CLMD and QAD Chiefs as well as four (4) Chief Trainers already pre-determined by the region in coordination with NEAP. This means that the CLMD chief or representative will serve as the fifth chief trainer. For the criteria in the selection of NTOT participants, please refer to the NEAP Memorandum dated March 16, 2016 entitled *Screening of NEAP Trainer-Facilitators for the Grade 11 Teacher Training*.
3. Billeting assignments by region are attached here as Attachment 2.
4. The Regional Management Team will check-in on April 24 and attend the Orientation with BCD and NEAP on April 25 from 8:00am to 5:00 pm at DepED Ecotech Center.
5. All Session Guides (SGs) were e-mailed to the HRDD Chiefs on April 15. All regions are requested to conduct their own walk-through prior to the NTOT.
6. The rest of the participants will check-in on April 25 and must attend the Opening Program on April 26 at 8am. Their first meal shall be dinner of April 25 while the last meal shall be afternoon snacks of April 29.
7. The Closing Program will be on April 29 at 3:00 pm.
8. The specific class assignments of the Chief Trainers and participants will be sent to the regions in a separate advisory to be issued by NEAP.

Reminders for the NTOT participants of the **TVL Track**:

1. List of Chief Trainers are attached here as Attachment 3.
2. Chief Trainers are advised to be at DAP, Tagaytay City on April 24 at 1:00 pm for the briefing meeting with the training committees. They are expected to take part as National Trainers during the Mass Training for Senior High School Teachers.
3. Arrival, registration and billeting of participants at the venue shall start at 8:00 am on April 25, First meal is lunch on the said date and last meal is afternoon snacks of April 29. Opening program will start at 1:00 pm.
4. The criteria for selecting the National Trainer are as follows:
 - a. has served as a K to 12 trainer;
 - b. is at least a National Certificate II (NC II) holder;
 - c. possess excellent communication and facilitation skills;
 - d. be physically and mentally fit; and
 - e. preferably have a Trainers Methodology (TM) Certificate although not required.
